

IDAHO READING INDICATOR (CONT): In Pre-first and First grades, students can be proficient in one of two areas, whichever is higher: letter sounds or reading fluency. While the data shows a drop of 8% in Pre-first and 2% in First grade, the students' reading fluency soared. There were 12 students proficient in the fall and 40 proficient in the winter. Students and teachers are working hard!

WINTER ASSESSMENTS: Students took the MAP Assessments in December and will be taking the Direct Writing Assessment (DWA) in January.
