## RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF BRACKETT INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

## **RESOLUTION #2526-07**

WHEREAS, Texas law (Agriculture Code, Title-2, Chapter 12, Section 12.0029) requires public school food authorities ("SFAs") with 50 percent or more of enrolled students eligible for free or reduced-price meals in the National School Lunch Program to provide a summer meal program for a minimum of 30 calendar days during the summer months.

WHEREAS, Brackett Independent School District ("District) meets this requirement.

WHEREAS, State law provides options for SFAs meeting the requirement.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ("Board") OF THE BRACKETT INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

**RESOLVED**, the Board of Trustees selects the available Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) option to opt out of the summer nutrition program by requesting a waiver for participation due to "Transportation is an insurmountable obstacle to program operations".

**RESOLVED**, the Board of Trustees will send written notice of the district's intention to the district's local School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) no later than November 30, 2025.

**RESOLVED**, the Board of Trustees directs the Food Service Manager to comply with TDA deadlines, waiver applications, documentation and all other compliance requirements.
