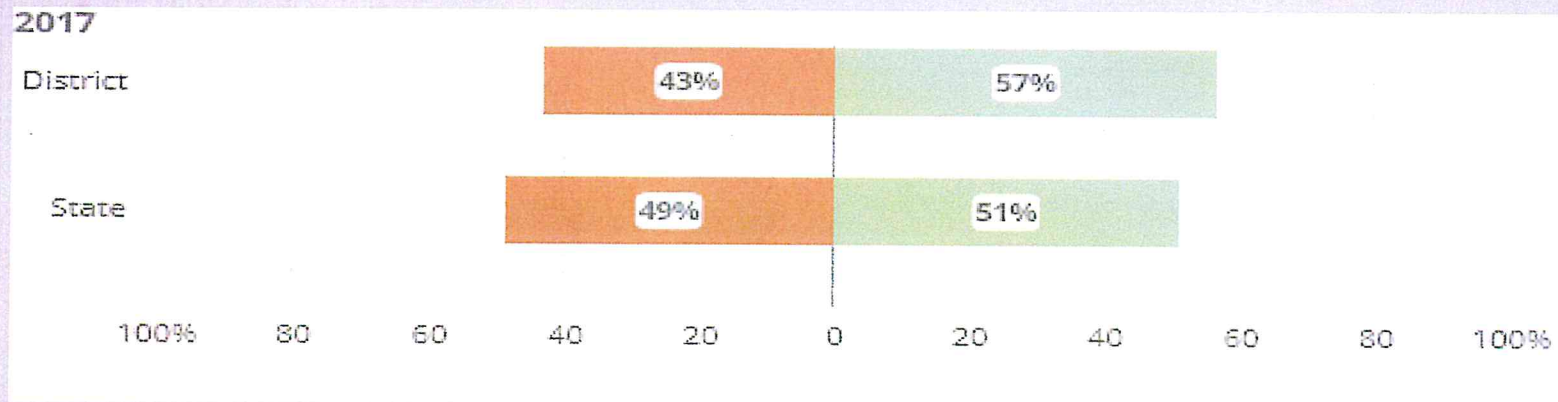
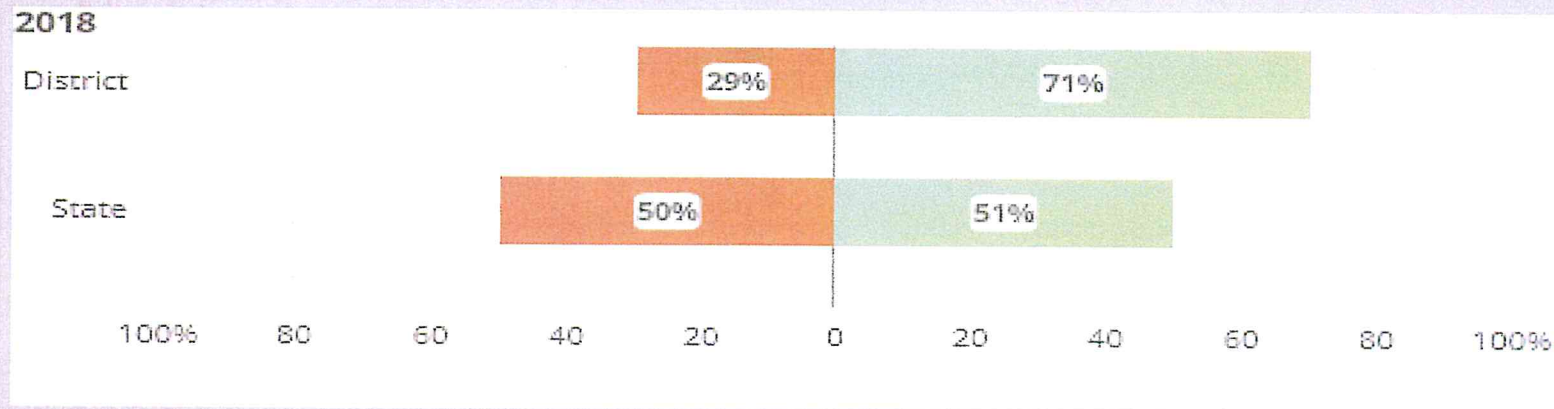


# Snapshot: Academic Progress 2018

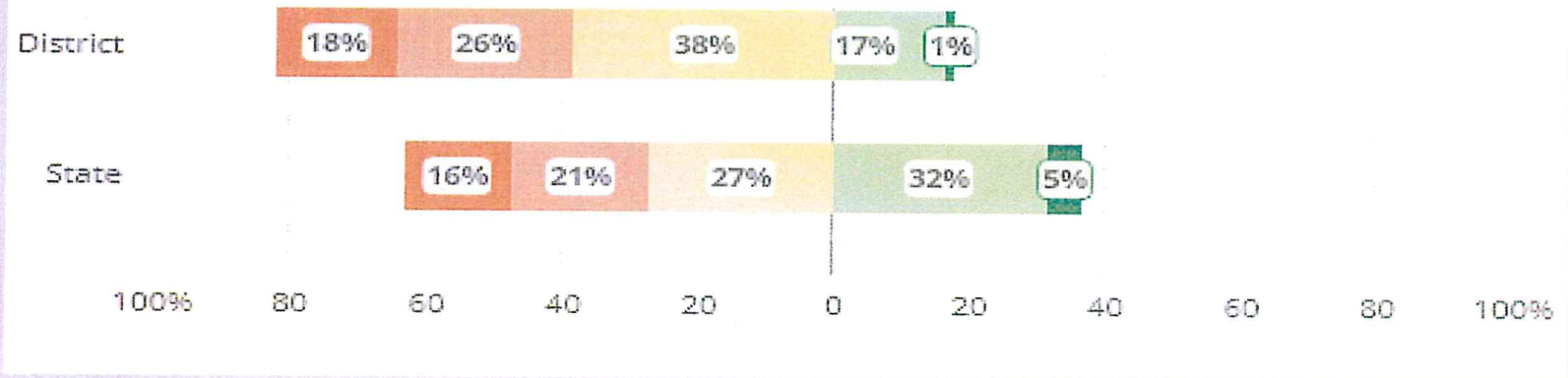

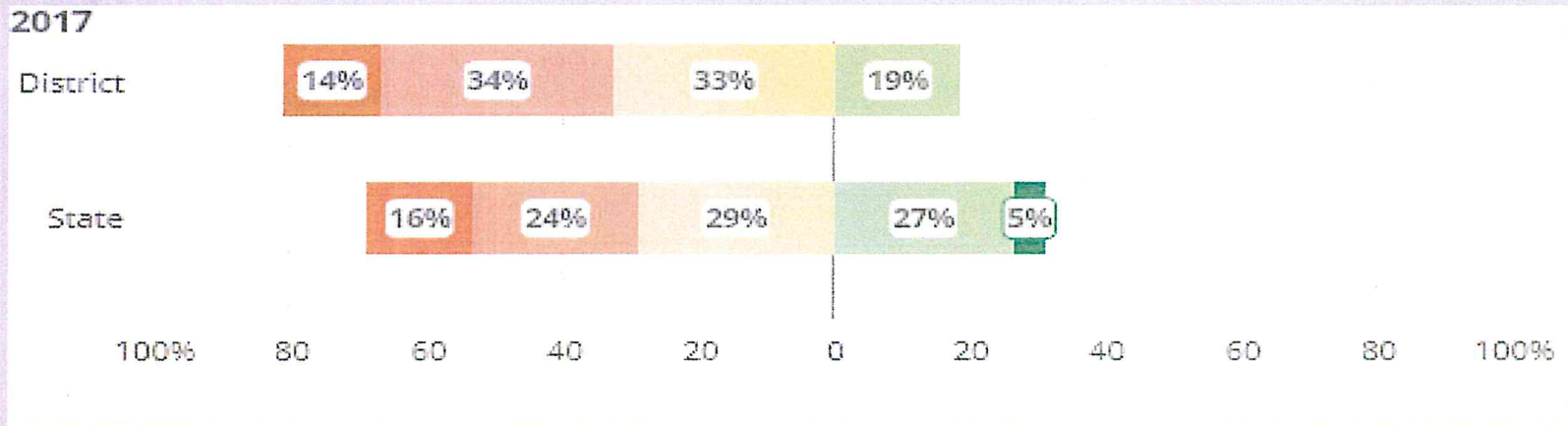
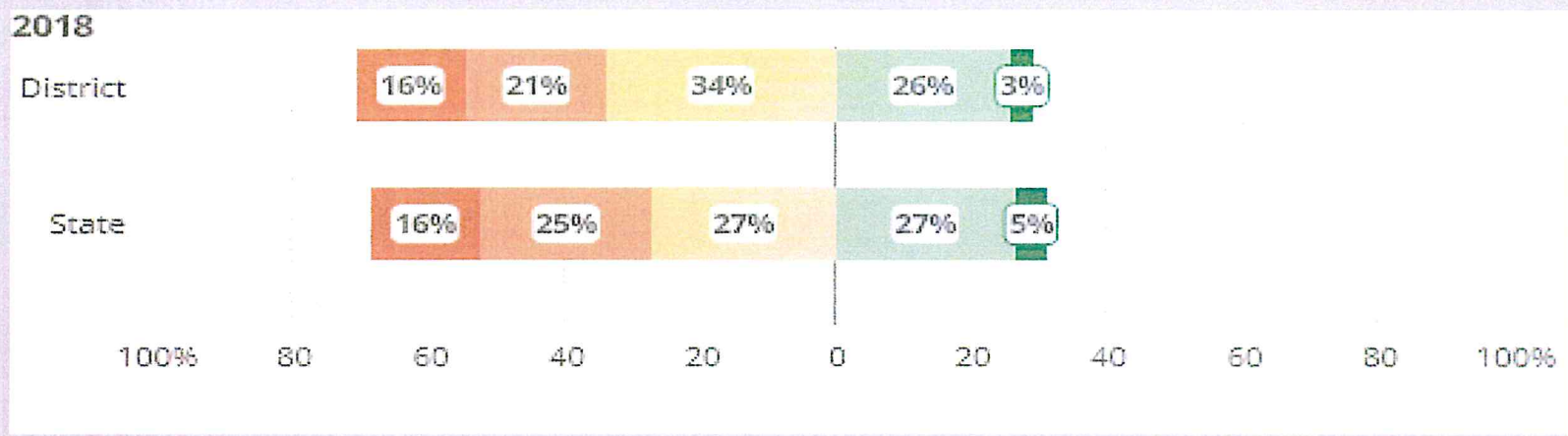

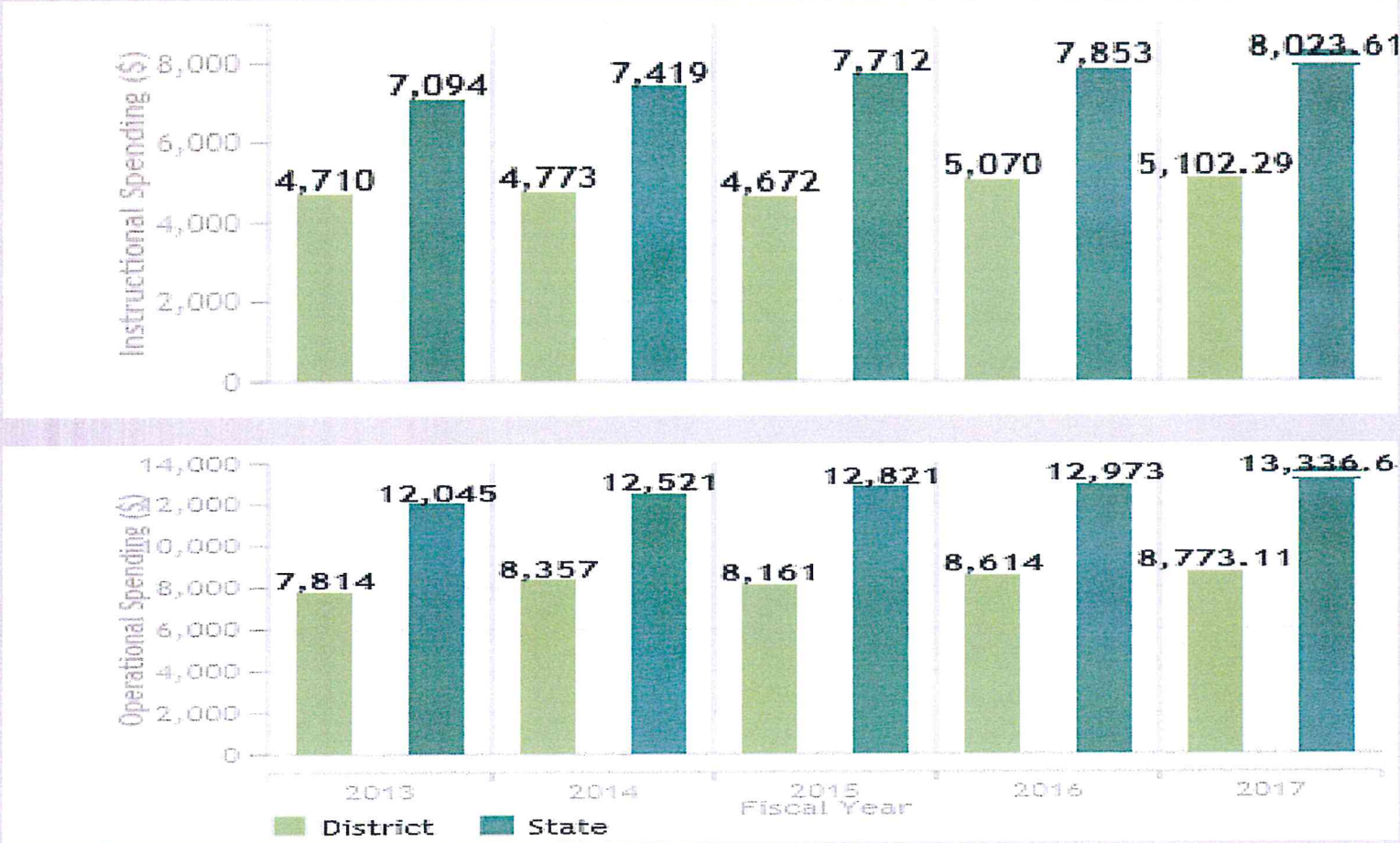

- Average Class Size: 15

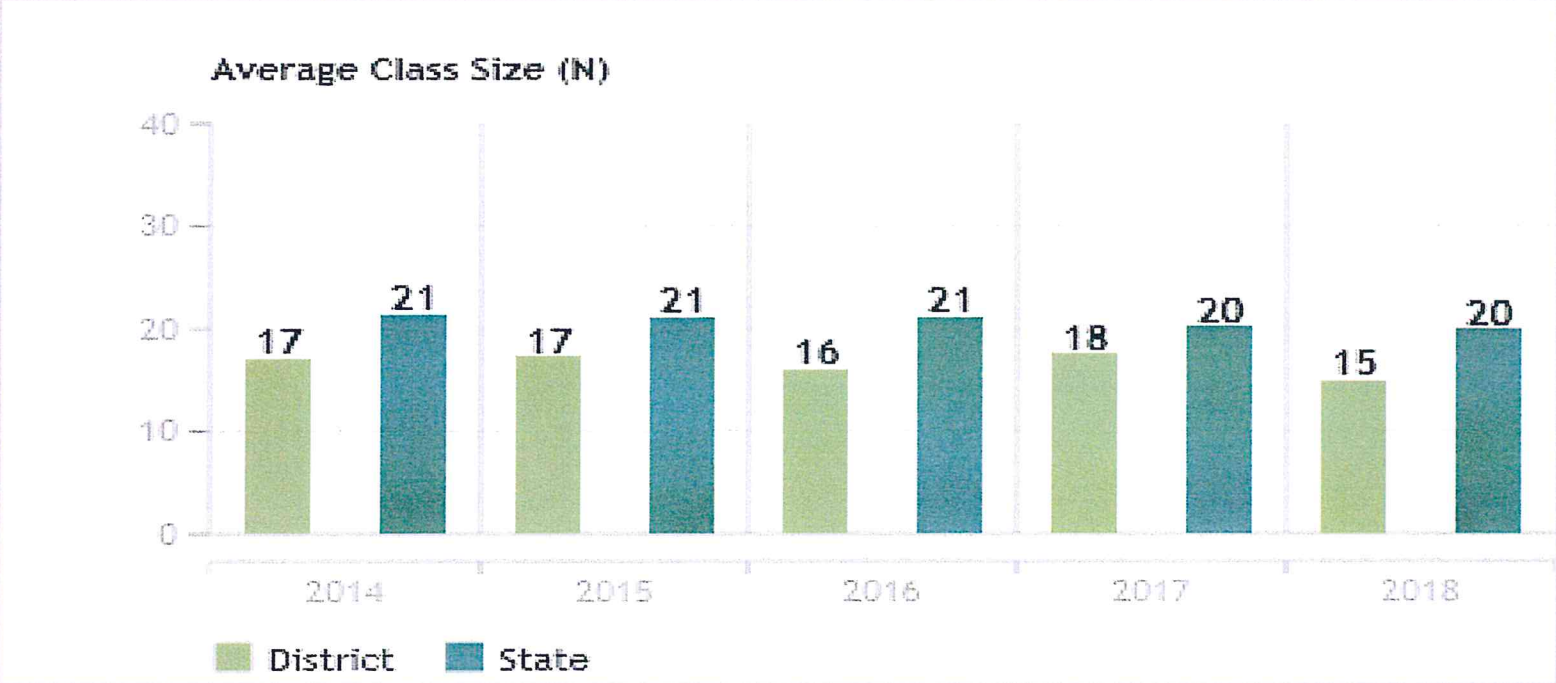


# Closer Look: Per Student Spending History



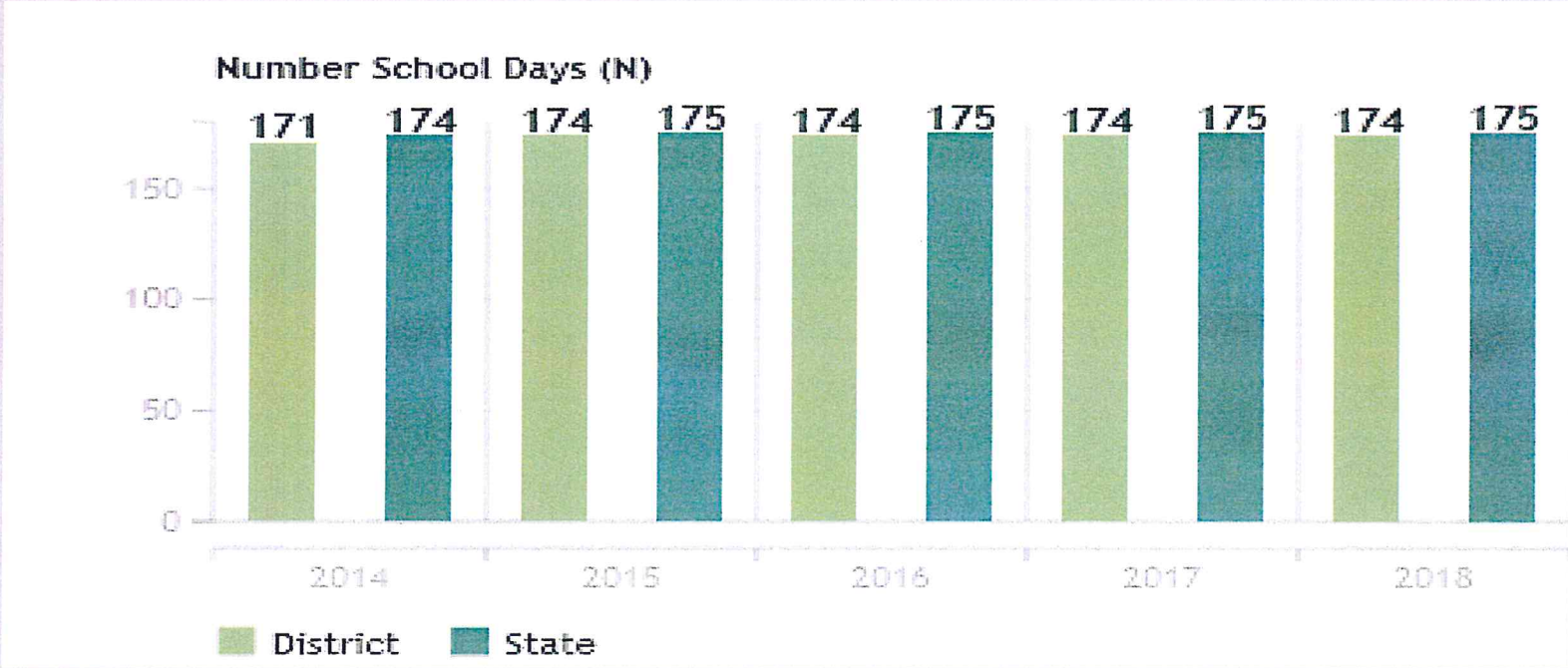


# Closer Look: Average Class Size





# Closer Look: Number of School Days



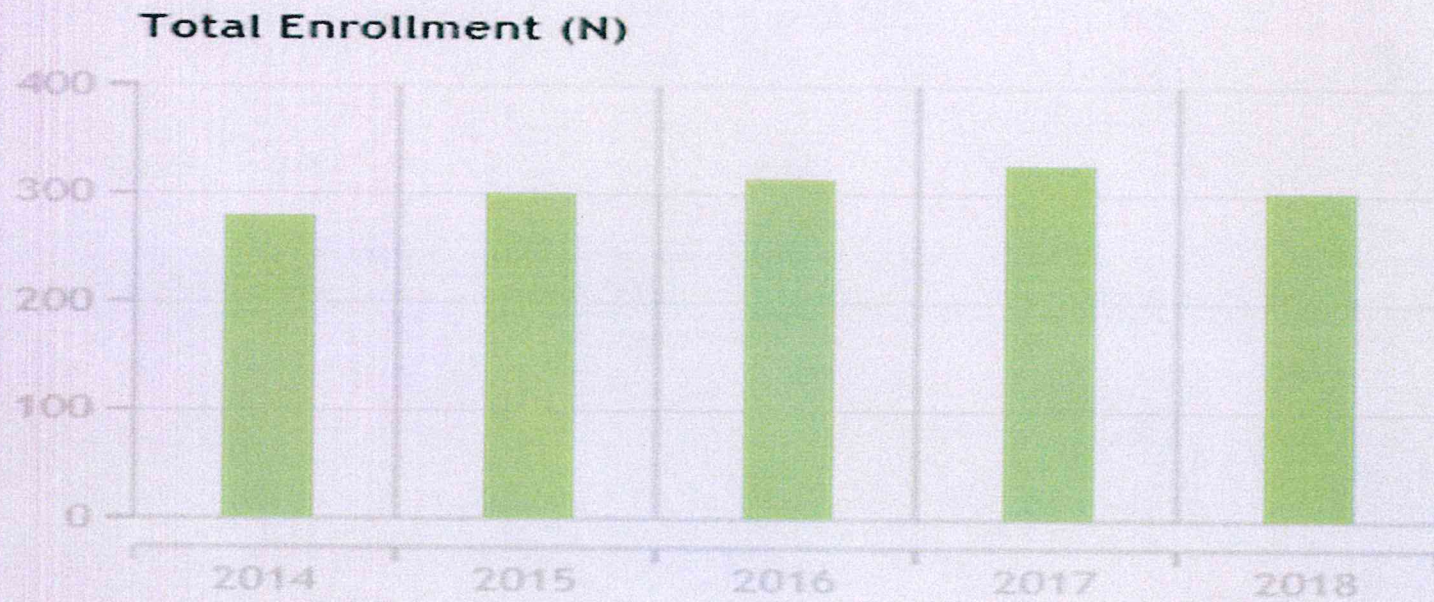

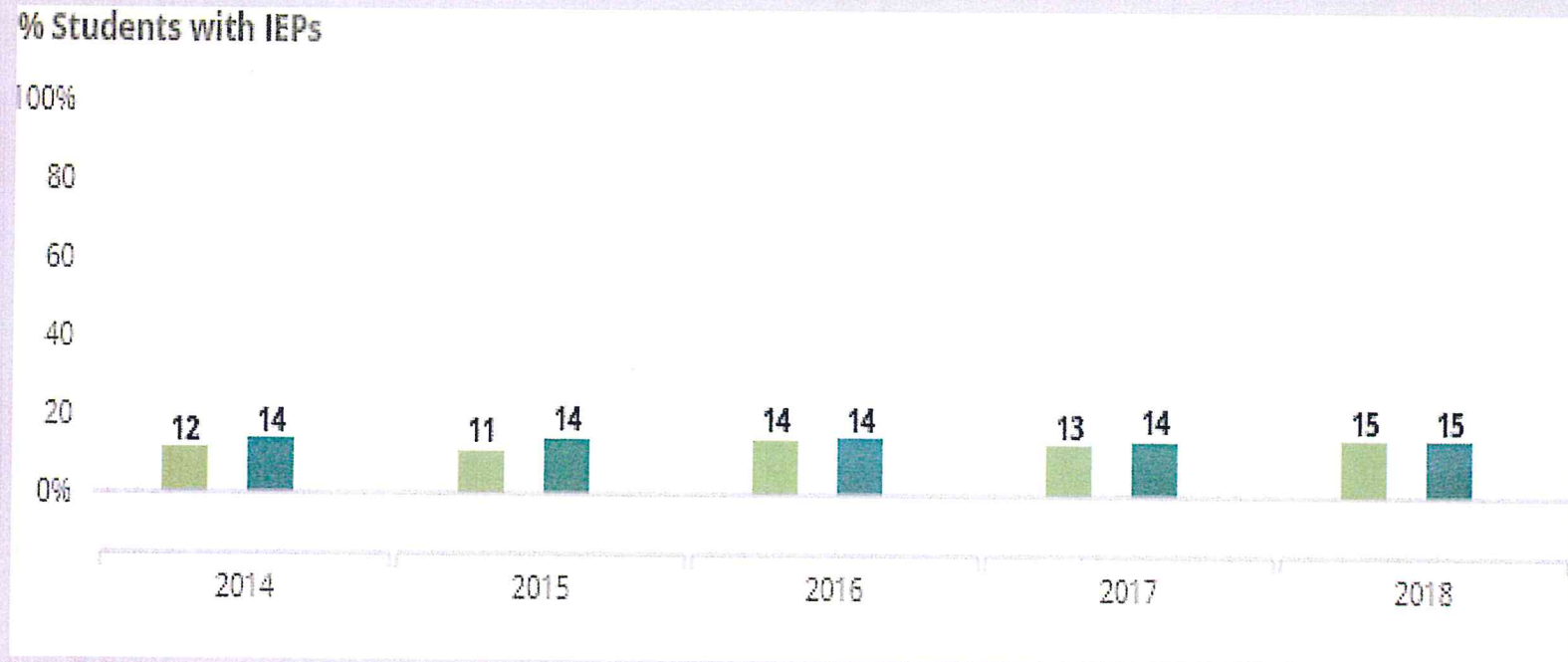


# Closer Look: Enrollment



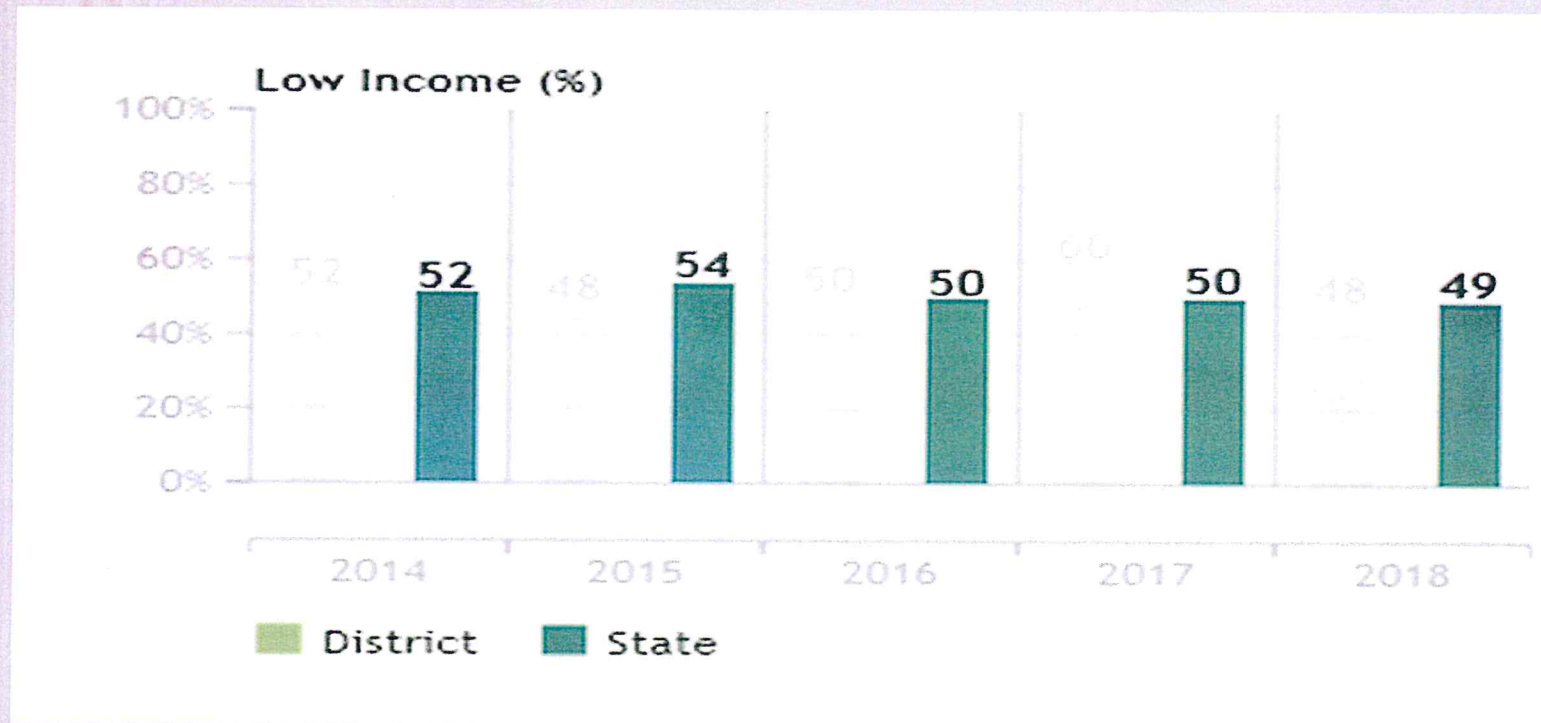


# Closer Look: Percent with Disabilities





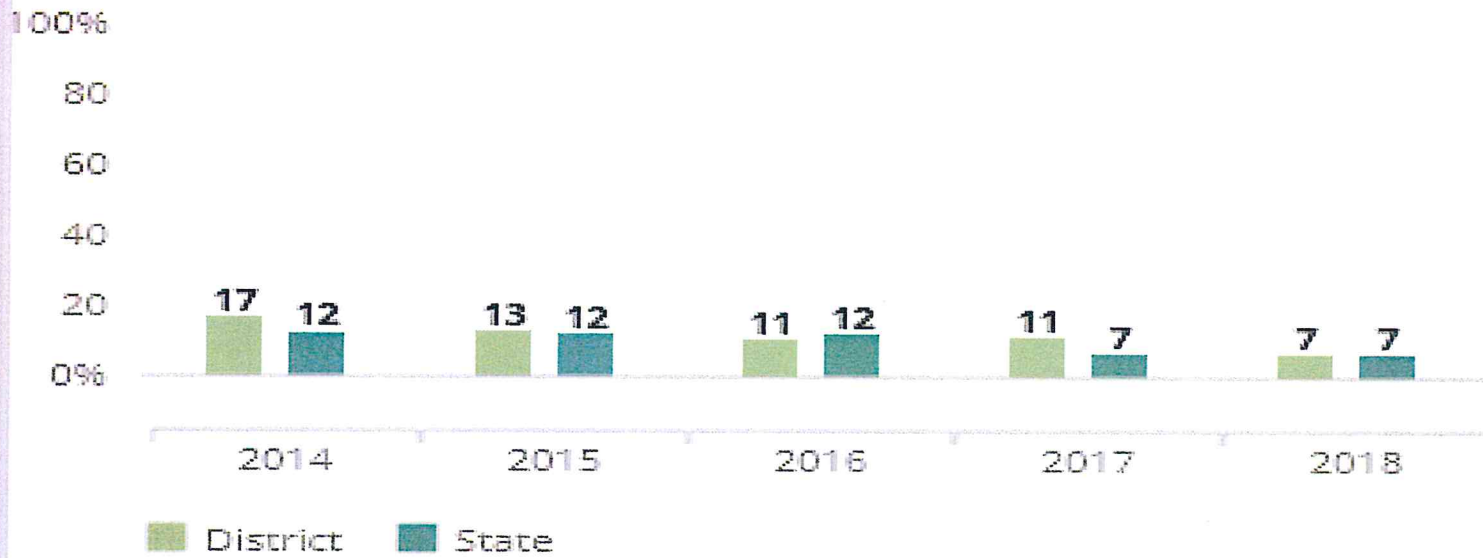
# Closer Look: Percent Low Income





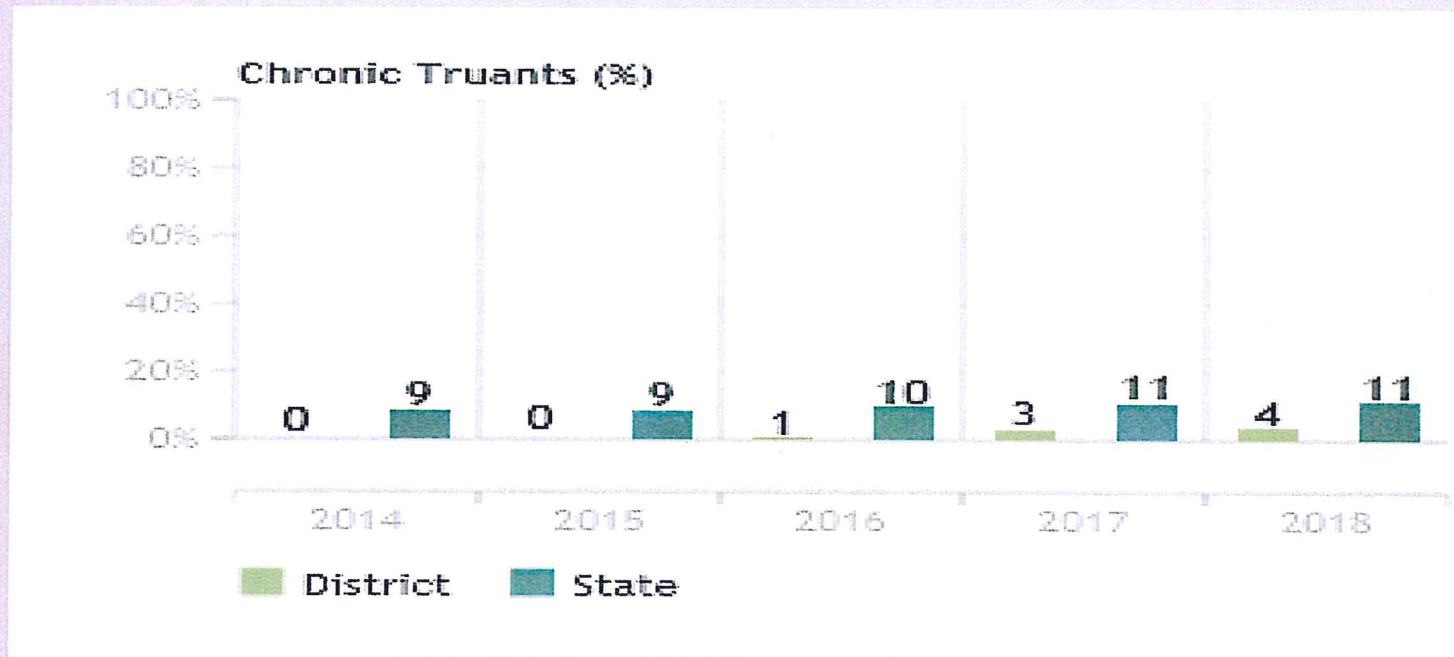
# Closer Look: Mobility Rate
