Resolution to Declare a Good Cause Exception for House Bill 3 – Armed Security Officer Requirement

#### **Background Information**

The Texas Legislature passed House Bill 3, which creates an unfunded mandate for school boards to ensure that at least one-armed security officer is present during regular school hours at each campus. The new law requires that the armed security officer be a commissioned peace officer, namely a school district peace officer, a school resource officer, or a commissioned peace officer employed as security personnel under Texas Education Code § 37.081. Texas Education Code § 37.0814 provides that if a school board is unable to comply with this requirement, the board may claim a good cause exception if the district's noncompliance is due to the lack of availability of funding or qualified personnel.
