

5Essentials School Survey Overview 2025







What is the 5Essentials Survey?

- Required by Illinois State Board of Education
- Administered annually to students and staff by school; parents are also encouraged to participate in a separate survey
- Developed by University of Chicago based on 20 years of school improvement research, indicating that schools with strong essential indicators predicate success
- Raw data are based on a core of 80 student and 150 teacher questions, compiled into 22 measures of school climate and practice, reflecting "5 essential" components

- Effective Leaders
- Collaborative Teachers
- Ambitious Instruction
- Supportive Environment
- Involved Families



Strong Survey Participation in District 90

- The response rate for teachers and students was 93% across the District
- All groups met the thresholds needed to receive data

Roosevelt School	95.8%	85.7%	37.4%
Willard Elem School	99.9%	83.7%	32.1%




Overview - "Heat Map" Image

Overall, River Forest SD 90 are wellorganized for improvement on average.






Category Shifts: 2024-25

- · support efforts to strengthen its students' community resources.





- · they find teachers trust-worthy and responsive to their academic needs,
- all students value hard work, and
- · teachers push all students toward high academic performance.





Ambitious Instruction

How is River Forest SD 90 performing on Ambitious Instruction?

In schools with strong Ambitious Instruction, classes are challenging and engaging. The instruction is clear, well-structured, and encourages students to build and apply knowledge. When combined with a supportive environment, Ambitious Instruction has the most direct effect on student learning. It is:

- · well-defined with clear expectations for student success,
- · interactive and encourages students to build and apply knowledge,
- well-paced (not measured), and
- · aligned across grades (not measured).





Effective Leaders

How is River Forest SD 90 performing on Effective Leaders?

In schools with Effective Leaders, principals and teachers work together to implement a shared vision. In such schools, people, programs, and resources are focused on a vision for sustained improvement. Leaders:

- · practice shared leadership,
- · set high goals for quality instruction,
- maintain mutually trusting and respectful relationships,
 support professional advancement for faculty and staff, and
- manage resources for sustained program improvement (not measured).





Parent Survey Data – Areas of Relative Strength

- Parent Satisfaction (Overall satisfaction) Very/Somewhat: 94%
- Parent-Student Interaction (Talk about day) Always/Usually: 98%
- Parent Assessment of Teacher Trust (Respect/Child's Interest at Heart) Strongly Agree/Agree:
 98%
- Quality of School Facilities (Cleanliness) Excellent/Good: 98%
- School Safety (Child feels safe) Great Extent/Somewhat: 97%
- School Outreach (Informed about News/Information) Every Time/Often: 99%
- Parent Involvement in School (Attend Parent-Teacher conferences) Always/Usually: 92%



Parent Survey Data – Relative Areas for Growth

- Parent Connectedness (Voice valued at school) Great Extent/Somewhat: 86%
- Parent Connectedness (Important part of improving school) Great Extent/Somewhat: 81%
- Parent Involvement/Disruptions (Work obligations) Always/Usually: 43%
- Parent Involvement/Disruptions (Events scheduled when can't attend) Always/Usually: 13%
- Parent Teacher Interaction (Listen to my suggestions) 2-3 Times Per Month/Once a Week or More: 24%
- School Safety (Child affected by bullying) Not at All/A Little: 85%
