## Notice of Proposed Property Tax Increase for Putnam County Community Unit School District #535

- I. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Putnam County Community Unit School District #535 for 2024 will be held on December 16, 2025 at 6:30 pm at Putnam County Primary School, Media Center, 400 E. Silverspoon Avenue, Granville, Illinois 61326.
  - Any person desiring to appear at the public hearing and present testimony to the taxing district may contact Dr. Clayton J. Theisinger, Superintendent, 400 E. Silverspoon Avenue, Granville, Illinois 61326, (815)882-2800 ext. 5.
- II. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2024 were \$7,993,393.00.
  - The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2025 are \$8,875,900. This represents a 11.04% increase over the previous year.
- III. The property taxes extended for debt service and public building commission leases for 2024 were \$0.
  - The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service and public building commission leases for 2025 are \$0. This represents a 0% increase over the previous year.
- IV. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2024 were \$7,993,393.00.
  - The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2025 are \$8,875,900.00. This represents a 11.04% increase over the previous year.

Posting must conform with requirements for publishing according to Truth in Taxation Act, which are as follows:

The notice must be published no more than 14 days nor less than seven days prior to the date of the public hearing. The notice must be no less than one-eighth page in size, and the smallest type that can be used is 12 point. The notice must be enclosed in a black border no less than 1/4 inch wide. The notice cannot be placed in that portion of the newspaper where legal notices and classified advertisements appear.
