- Benchmarking
 - MCT-II practice test are administered twice a year—once each semester
 - Writing benchmarks are not administered.
 - Orchard is utilized for universal screening (Response to Intervention).
 - TerraNova is administered at the end of the year to compare our middle school students to other middle school students nationally.
- Pacing Guides
 - Pacing guides are followed in each subject area.
 - Pacing guides are updated at the beginning of each school year.

TMS

- Benchmarking
 - MCT-II practice test are administered every 9 weeks.
 - Writing benchmarks are not administered.
 - Science benchmarks are not administered.
 - Orchard is utilized for universal screening (Response to Intervention)
 - TerraNova is administered at the end of the year to compare our middle school students to other middle school students nationally.
- Pacing Guides
 - Departments develop pacing guides for each nine weeks.
 - Departments have common planning time and develop lesson plans for their subject area weekly.
 - Pacing Guides are constantly updated since the assessment has changed.
 - Teachers on the state committees develop the assessment items in Language, Writing, and Math.

THS

- Benchmarking
 - Subject Area Practice Tests are given throughout the year but is not formalized as benchmarks.
 - Teacher creates the practice test from samples provided by MDE.
- Pacing Guides
 - Pacing guides are not updated and are not used regularly.

 - Pacing guides do not drive lesson planning and/or benchmarking.
