

Consider approval of 2025-2026  
hazardous transportation routes

1. Background:

Policy CNA(LOCAL) transportation management, student transportation must be updated annually. The policy states that *If the District applies for the additional transportation allotment provided by the state for students who live within two miles of a school campus, the Board shall adopt a resolution to identify hazardous traffic conditions or areas presenting a high risk of violence within two miles of the school campus. The resolution shall include the specific hazardous or high-risk areas in which transportation shall be provided, and the District shall publish the locations of these routes. The Board shall adopt a revised resolution when necessary to accurately reflect changes to the conditions or areas.*

2. Process:

The Southwest ISD transportation department annually submits a resolution to the board to identify those areas that are deemed hazardous. Transportation staff has compiled the various hazardous routes and provided the required information to allow the board to certify a resolution that identifies all hazardous areas within the district outlined by CNA(LOCAL). The resolution, once certified by the board, will be posted to the district website.
