

- Trump Tower, St. Regis Tower, Marina City Complex
- Wrigley Building
- Aqua Tower 3rd tallest building in Chitown Female architect
- Starbucks (Chitown's ONLY spiral escalator-only a few hundred in world AND largest roastery in the world)
- Tribune Tower (Embedded on outside are artifacts from all over the world)
- o Iconic Chicago: Cloud Gate (Known as the Bean) and Chicago Theatre Sign (State St)

History

- Water Tower one of handful of buildings that didn't burn in Chicago Fire of 1871
- Macy's storefront displays First to ever host an in-person Santa & have intricate window displays over the holidays
- Palmer House \$1 million Tiffany doors (signature of the hotel) and world's first brownie created here in 1893
- Griffin Museum of Science & Industry
