### **Board Goal**

IV. Parent and Community Involvement In pursuit of excellence, the district will foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students.

#### Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the sixth grading cycle (April 18, 2016 – June 2, 2016). Also, the overall attendance for the 2015-2016 school year is provided. Finally, there is attendance comparison for the three years prior.

#### **Objectives**

- District-wide totals based on number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report
- Attendance figures are based on 33 instructional days (sixth cycle)
- Attendance for the school year is based on 177 instructional days

## **Operational Impact**

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

#### **Results**

- The total attendance percentage for the Denton ISD for Cycle 6 is 95.5%.
- The lowest total attendance average is for 12<sup>th</sup> grade students at 90.3 % followed by 11<sup>th</sup> grade students at 93.4%
- The highest attendance averages are in grades 3, 4, 5 at 96.9%
- The district total for 2015-2016 is 95.9%
- 6<sup>th</sup> cycle reflects testing days and final exam days
