Before October 30 th		Chief Appraiser shall prepare a ballot listing the candidates alphabetically whose names were timely submitted and deliver it to the presiding officer of the governing body of each taxing unit.
Before December 15 th		The governing body of each taxing unit entitled to vote shall select its candidate(s) and cast its votes <u>by resolution</u> and submit it to the Chief Appraiser by the deadline.
Before December 31st		The Chief Appraiser shall count the votes, declare the five candidates and submit the results to the governing body of each taxing unit and to the candidates. The Chief Appraiser shall resolve a tie vote by any method of chance
