**Title:** Bordeaux, France 2027 International Travel Request - Normandale Elementary School - Lynnea West

**Type:** Discussion

**Background:** In accordance with Policy 538, the following international student travel experience for up to 35 Normandale Elementary students for two weeks in June 2027 has received support from the school's administration. Participating students will miss zero school days for this travel experience.

This experience is coordinated by Xperitas, a leader in delivering authentic language and cultural immersion programs for Spanish, French and German languages. **Overview of Standards that will be taught on the Travel Experience:**

**Educational Goal:**

To develop students' intercultural understanding, language skills, and global citizenship by immersing them in authentic French family and community life.

**Intercultural Understanding:**

Students will gain firsthand experience with French customs, traditions, and daily routines, building appreciation for perspectives different from their own.

**Language Development:**

Students will strengthen their ability to listen, speak, and read in French through natural, everyday interactions with native speakers.

**Global Citizenship:**

Students will begin to see themselves as part of a global community, recognizing both similarities and differences among cultures.

**Social and Emotional Growth:**

Students will develop adaptability, independence, and empathy by engaging respectfully in a new environment and forming connections within their host families.

**Reflection and Connection:**

Students will reflect on their experiences to connect what they've learned in school to real-world contexts and to share their insights with peers upon returning home.
