Dear district leadership,

I am writing to thank you for your difficult but pragmatic and humane decision to defer reopening school until early next year.

While Oregon has remained one of the best states in the country related to controlling the spread of COVID, we still have far more cases than we should if we were to consider reopening. The past few weeks have shown a consistent upward trend, and the past several months have shown us not only is the virus more easily spread than first thought, but that people can experience reinfection.
