

AP Studio Art:
Grades 11,12

AP Studio Art is designed for students who are seriously interested in the practical experience of art. Students submit portfolios for evaluation at the end of the school year. The AP Studio Art will offer a choice of three portfolios: Drawing, 2-D Design and 3-D Design. The portfolios share a basic, three section structure which requires the student to show a fundamental competence and range of understanding in visual concerns (and methods). This course will enable junior and senior students to earn up to 2 credits and will require a teacher recommendation. Successful completion of the course will award 1 elective credit per year.

Driver's Education:
Grades 9-12

Driver's Education is designed to enable all drivers' education students in Texas to acquire the essential knowledge, skills and experiences to perform reduced risk driving practices in the total traffic environment by completing a driver's education and traffic safety course. Successful completion of the one semester Driver's Education and Traffic Safety course will award one half state credit.

Special Topics in Social Studies:
Grade 11,12

This course will be a special topics class in the social studies department for juniors and seniors to earn up to 2 elective credits. The course will meet the state standards and knowledge and skills for special topics in social studies. The course will explore and study the Bible and its impact on world literature, history, art and culture. Instructional materials and lessons will be academic in nature and not devotional.
(This course cannot substitute for required social studies credits.)
