In pursuit of excellence, the district will foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students.

Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the fifth grading cycle (February 24, 2014 – April 18, 2014).

Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report.
- Attendance figures are based on 33 days (February 24, 2014 – April 18, 2014).

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for Cycle 5 is 95.6%.
- The lowest total attendance averages are for 12th graders at 91.89% followed by 11th graders at 93.79%.
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5th grade at 96.65% followed by 4th grade at 96.58%.
- Comparison: 2013's fifth grading cycle was 95.92%.
