Hi Michael,

I wanted to follow up on the Metro redistricting issue. First, I want to make sure my understanding of the issue is correct: Parkrose extends, generally speaking, from 82nd to 147th, but the current Metro district boundary runs along 122nd, splitting Parkrose. The proposals for new districts all generally maintain this 122nd boundary. Is that correct? The preference of the district would be to include the area north of Halsey between 122nd-147th with the rest of Parkrose in any future districts?
