Last year we had a total of 31,692 student visits (up 7459 visits from last year) ; 14,062 medication administrations (up 7872 from last year) and 960 special procedures (up 477 from last year)

Vision Screenings:

- 1635 students screened
- 181 referred for further evaluation

Hearing Screenings:

- 1635 students screened
- 76 referred for further evaluation

Acanthosis Screenings:

- 1572 students screened
- 19 referred for further evaluation

Spinal screenings:

- 365 students screened
- 6 referred for further evaluation

Immunizations-

- Review and maintain current immunization records monthly
- Back to school immunizations are reviewed, inputted into the computer and if needed followed up with parent / guardian to maintain compliance
 - o 240 seventh grade students – need 2 new immunizations = 480 immunizations
 - o 251 kindergarten students = approximately 25 immunizations / student = 6,275 immunizations
 - o 241 new pre k students = approximately 25 immunizations / student = 6,025 immunizations
