
Libraries

As an example, we discovered that there were no origami books, which are quite popular with the students. Also, there is a great need for lower reading-level books for struggling readers. With those, and other needs in mind, we've already submitted a follow-up book order.

Also of note, our library assistants at all schools are now tracking Chromebooks. This has been done successfully at UHS for several years. Following the pattern set there, we've purchased small label makers for labeling all devices, and Desirae has been helping the other schools with how to use them.

Finally, October brought out the spooky books and scary stories, and the visit of a guest vampire reader at the MHES library. Few students will soon forget The Tailyo: A Ghost Story. But it was all in good fun.
