SMART GOALS:

English Language Arts

By May 2026, 80% of K-2 students will meet or exceed grade level benchmarks in aimsweb+ reading composite scores as measured by their spring benchmark assessment.

Math

By May 2026, 80% of K-2 students will meet or exceed grade level benchmarks in aimsweb+ math composite scores as measured by their spring benchmark assessment.

SEL

By May 2026, 80% of PreK-2 teachers will "respond favorably" when identifying students in the area of self management using the *Panorama Screener*.

ACTION STEP(S):

- 1. Continue implementing Structured Literacy with explicit phonological awareness and phonics instruction and utilizing aligned common resources
- 2. Provide tiered support using targeted small-group interventions and utilize progress monitoring systems to track student progress and adjust instruction as needed
- 3. Data Review: Grade-level teams and intervention staff will analyze benchmark and progress-monitoring data after each window to adjust interventions. Family Communication: Share AimswebPlus reports with families to highlight progress

Math

- 1. Increase alignment of common instructional practices across grade levels
- 2. Provide tiered support using targeted small-group interventions and utilize progress monitoring systems to track student progress and adjust instruction as needed
- 3. Data Review: Grade-level teams and intervention staff will analyze benchmark and progress-monitoring data after each window to adjust interventions
- 4. Family Communication: Share AimswebPlus reports with families to highlight progress

SEL

- 1. Students will begin to set age appropriate SEL goals and monitor their own progress toward those goals.
- 2. Ensure Morning Meetings are powerful, purposeful, and present throughout our building
- 3. Examine the impact of Second Step as our primary Tier 1 resource for explicit instruction
- 4. Regular meetings with administration, social workers, school psychologist, and Student Experience Coordinator to discuss student progress and response to supports and interventions
- 5. Strategies to increase engagement.
