Dear Fellow School Board Member,

It is with great honor and pleasure that I have accepted the nomination of the Laredo ISD Board of Trustees to the TASB Board of Directors. This letter is to request your support for my nomination.

As I respectfully ask for your support, there are two significant points that I wish to make. First, I would like to note that I bring a perspective that is not commonly found among the TASB Board of Directors. Prior to being a School Board Member, I served as Superintendent of Schools for five years in Carrizo Springs CISD. The retirement from CSCISD brought an end to 44 years of service to public schools as a teacher, counselor, principal, central office administrator, and superintendent. My commitment to students, parents, and school employees continues through my service as a School Board member at LISD where I am currently Secretary to the Board.

During this time I also served on the Laredo City Council (10 years), and on the Teachers Retirement System of Texas (five years). I currently serve on the Texas Woman's University Board of Regents and am the Purchasing Agent for Webb County. Thus, I have local government experience with the City, County, and School District.

I earned a bachelor's and master's degree from Texas Woman's University, an MBA in accounting from Laredo State University, and a doctorate of education from Texas A&M University at Kingsville.

I am the parent of five public school graduates, now college graduates, and the grandparent of 10 beautiful grandchildren, the oldest currently a student at UTPA. My husband of 43 years is a retired school principal and all of my children and their spouses have at one time been teachers.

I consider the aggregate of my experiences to be somewhat unique. These experiences along with the technical skills I have acquired will help me be a well-informed TASB Board of Directors member. If elected, I will strive to represent Region One wholeheartedly with my God-given abilities.

The second point I make with humility and caution. While Region One has two TASB Board of Director positions, Laredo has not had a member serve as director for nearly 20 years. I ask you as a School Board Member from the Region One area to support my candidacy as TASB Director. I need your help and would gratefully accept your support.

You may support my nomination to the TASB Board of Directors by voting as a board to endorse my nomination during your July or August School Board Meeting. Action of the Board to endorse must be submitted to TASB before August 29, 2012.
