## In process New Equipment Update

**Bryant:** Unit modification with new scope of work to complete heat source correctly to 7 rooms in process. AAON official to complete observation Wednesday 2/15/17 as well control panel will be replaced. On 2/9/17 MV Heating and Air Conditioning will turn dampers off to relieve cooling within building. Thermostats schedule to be moved in 7-10 classrooms due to a design issue causing heat to read wrong temperatures. Overall effects heat to process to computer cool down mode. Troubleshooting began during Christmas break to ensure we fix appropriate issues efficiently.

**Sandburg:** Install sump pump in crawl space next to boiler room. TBD additional pump installed under boil room. 2 inch shut off valves for each cut off for East and West (Drained valves to water for shut off in case of emergency. 80ft long pipe replaced thus far. Installed drain valve close to boil room. Replace 3 branches to shut off valves to 2 inch domestic water pipe.
