

PROPOSED REVISIONS

PRIOR APPROVAL	The Superintendent or designee shall establish and publish guidelines in the student handbook governing the use of correspondence courses <u>and online courses</u> as a means of earning graduation credit. Prior to enrollment in correspondence courses <u>or online courses</u> , a student shall make a written request to the principal or designee for approval to enroll in the course. If approval is not granted prior to enrollment, the student shall not be awarded credit toward graduation.
ELIGIBILITY	All <u>secondary</u> high school students shall be eligible to take correspondence courses <u>or online courses</u> and earn credit toward graduation.
LIMITATIONS	A student may earn a maximum of two state-required credits through correspondence courses. The Superintendent or designee may waive limitations on an individual basis for extenuating circumstances.
