# **Kaysville Junior High School**

**Reason for Amendment:** Kaysville Junior High School would like to provide professional learning for staff members at a High-Reliability Schools Conference and needs to increase the allocation for the Pre-ACT practice test for students, due to a delay in the billing cycle from last school year.

# • Current Academic Goals (no changes needed):

- 1. <u>Improvement in State Testing Proficiency</u> During the 2025-26 school year, Kaysville Junior High will increase the number of students who qualify as proficient on RISE and ASPIRE PLUS state assessments, specifically those who were previously below the proficiency level.
- 2. <u>Pre-ACT Benchmark Improvement</u> By the end of the 2025-26 school year, Kaysville Junior High will increase Pre-ACT benchmark scores in Math, Science, English, and Reading by two percentage points.

#### • Proposed Action Plan Amendments for Academic Goals:

- 1. <u>Improvement in State Testing Proficiency</u> Re-allocate \$2,500 in previously approved funding for tutoring and homework support (Knight Discovery), as well as designating \$6,000 in carryover funds for a total of \$8,500 to be used for staff professional development at a High-Reliability Schools Conference, intended to increase educator skills correlated with increased student academic outcomes.
- 2. <u>Pre-ACT Benchmark Improvement</u> Designate \$7,000 in carryover funds to be added to the Pre-ACT Practice to increase academic benchmark scores, bringing the total to \$14,000.
