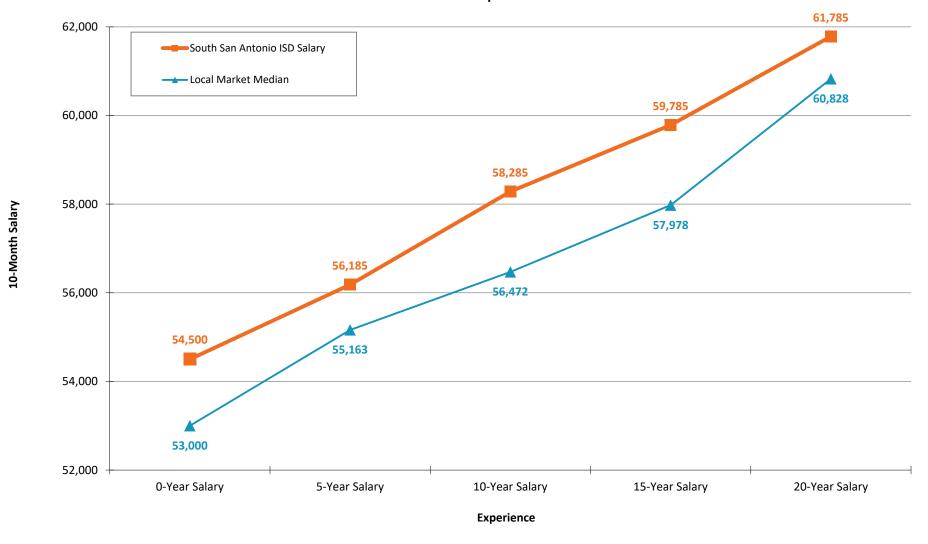

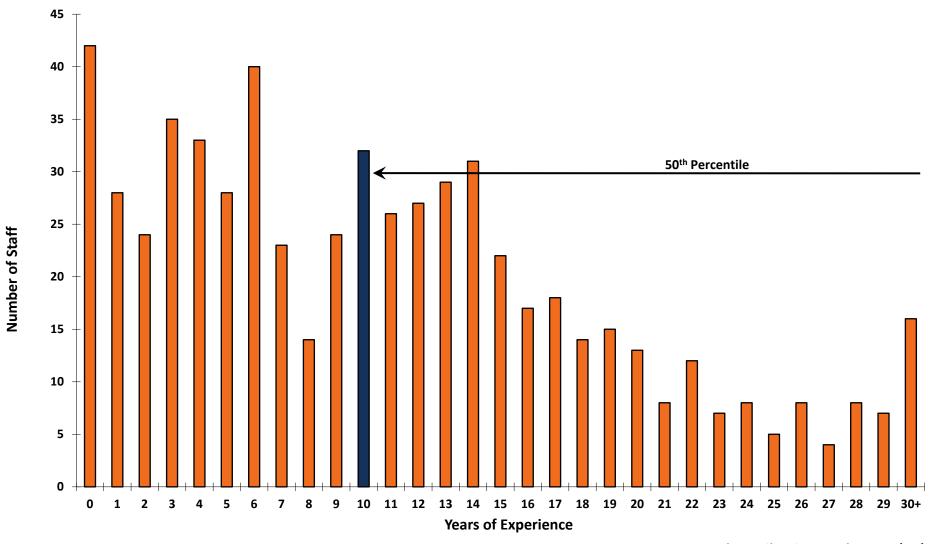

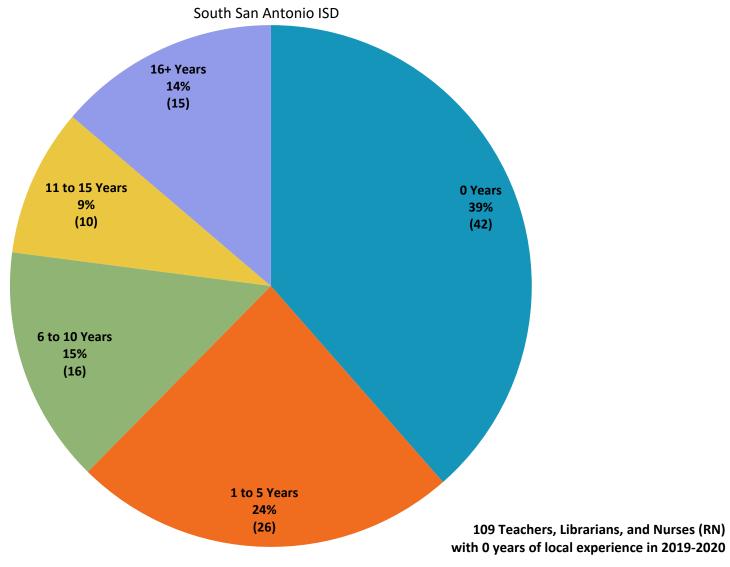

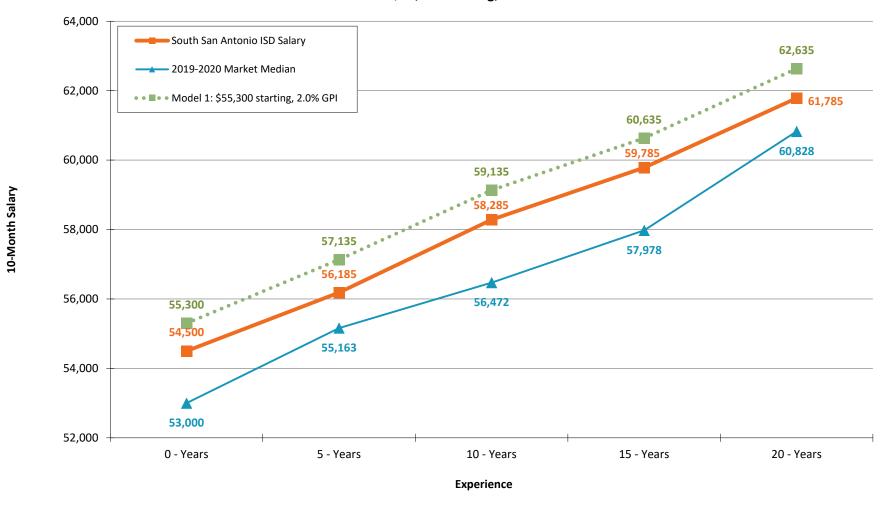

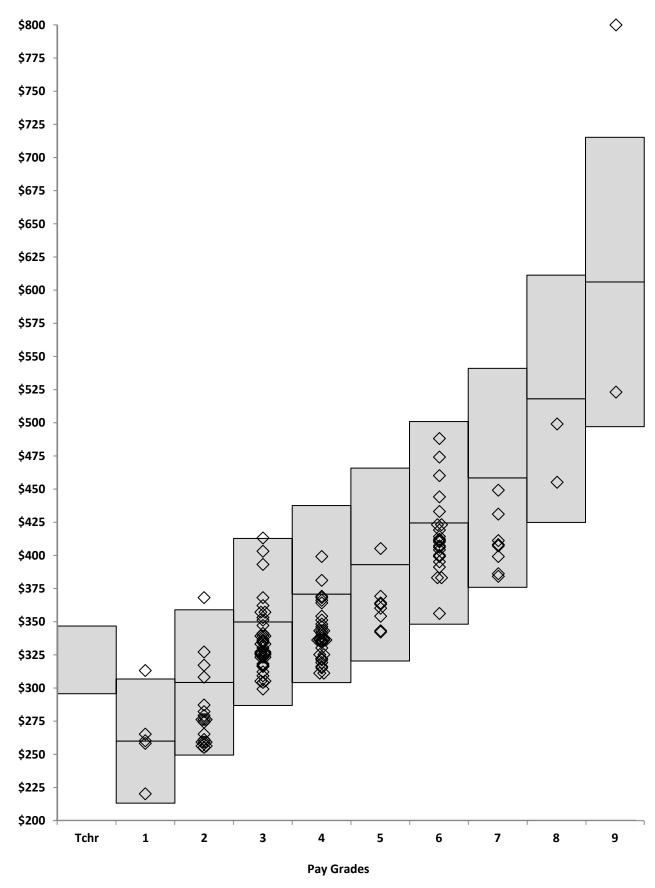

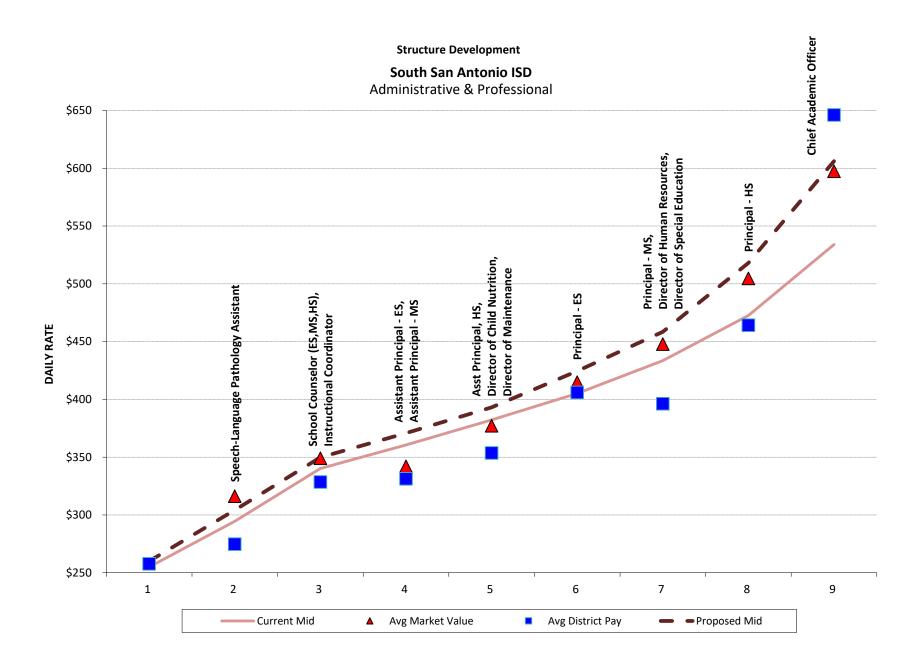

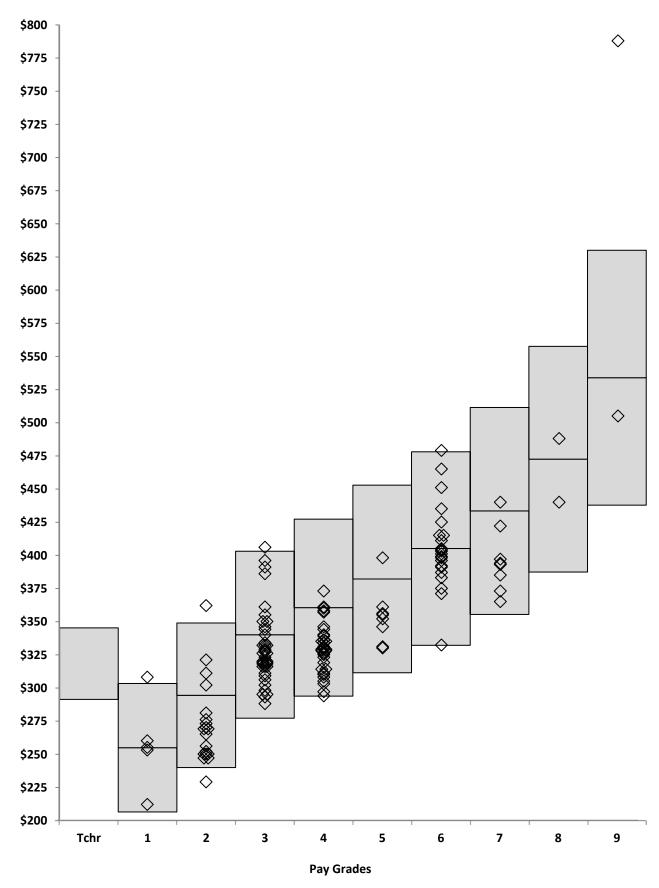

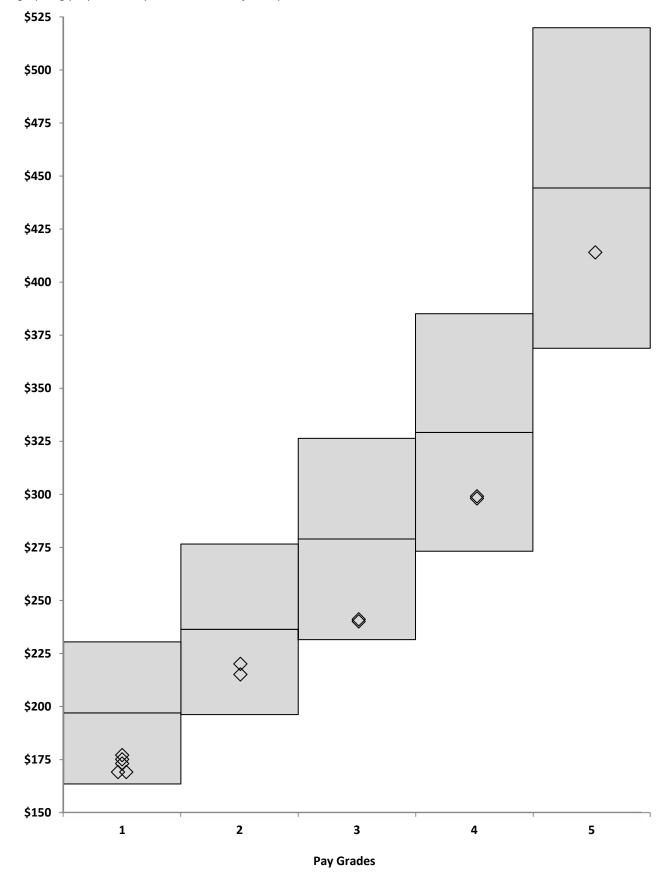




Proposed Pay vs. Proposed Structure - Technology

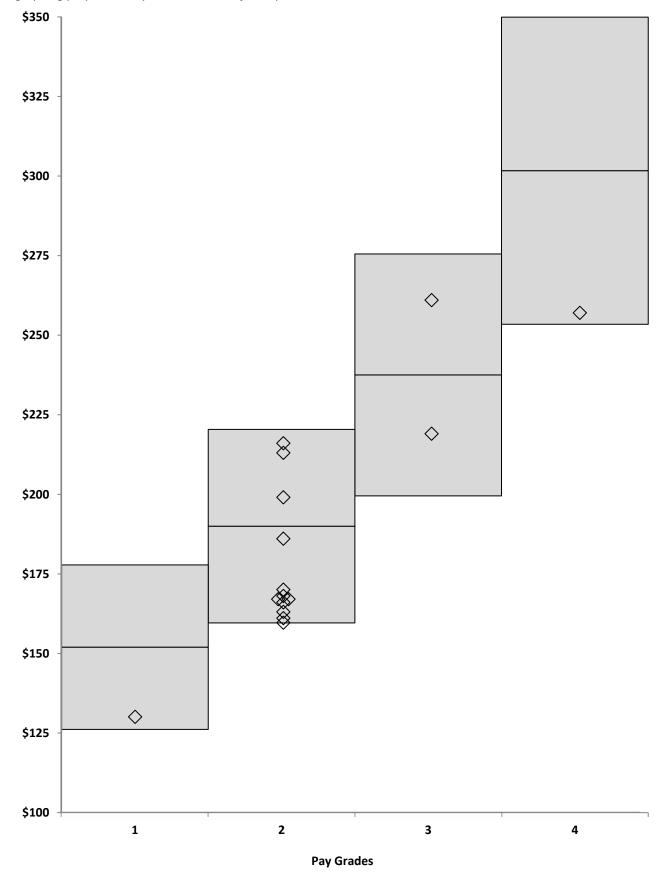

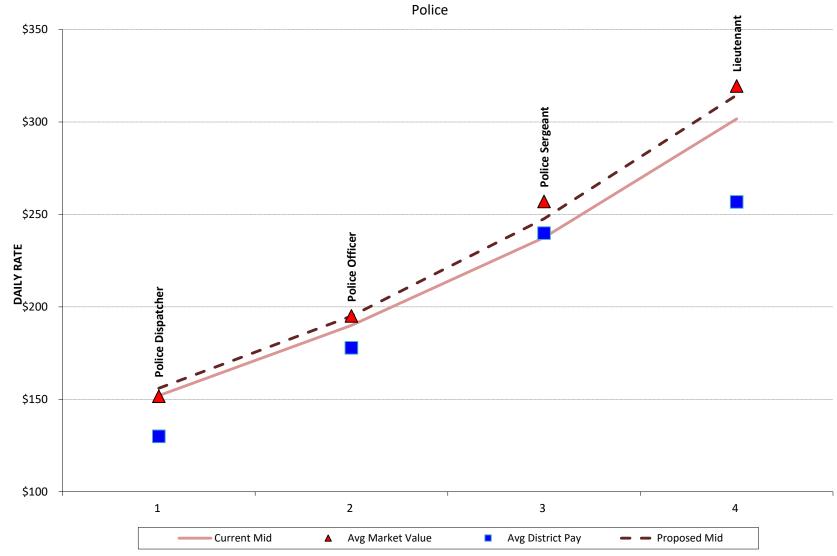
Current Pay vs. Current Structure - Police

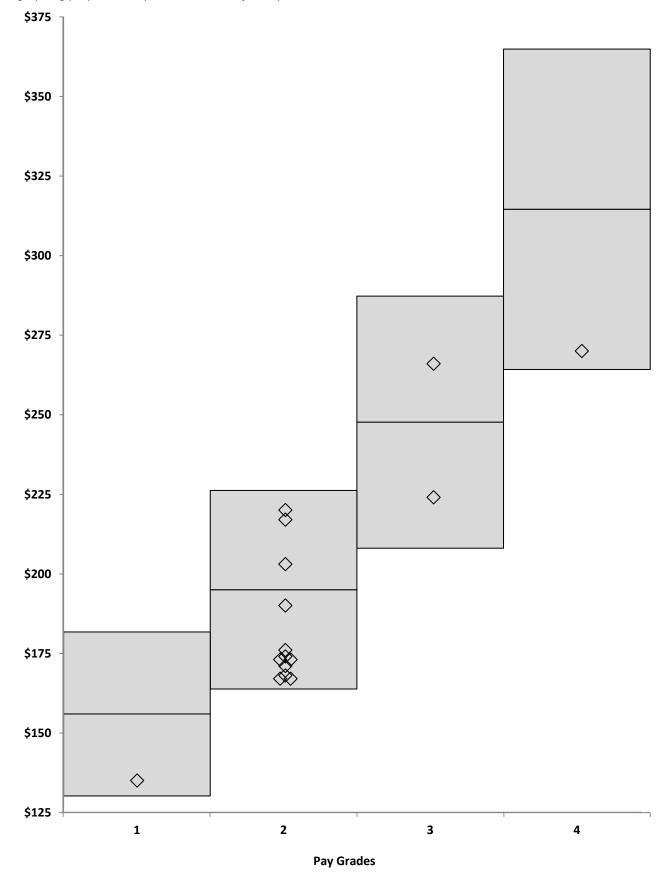
Structure Development
