BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

At the October 21, 2003 regular board meeting, the Board of Education approved a one-year interlocal cooperating contract with Bee County Community Action Agency to use Tyler elementary for the purpose of housing their Head Start Program. It was also stipulated that the administration explores the possibility of deeding the school to Bee County.

Since the completion of Hampton-Moreno-Dugat Early Childhood Center, Beeville ISD has not been using nor anticipates future use of this facility. County Attorney Mike Knight, surveyor Tom Dolezal, and Beeville ISD Administration conducted a search for a deed. A deed for the property was unable to be located.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

The Superintendent recommends that the BISD Board of Trustees authorize the resolution to donate the property to Bee County for use in the Head Start Program or another public purpose. A gift deed will be executed conveying BISD's interest in the building. The deed will convey the property "as is" and will include the required language from the Texas Education Code. The property will revert back to BISD if the county does not use the property for a public purpose such as the Head Start program or if the county tries to convey the property.
