Who is eligible for STAAR-Alt? Participation Requirements

- 1. The student must have a significant cognitive disability
- 2. The student requires specialized supports to access the grade-level curriculum and environment
- 3. The student requires intensive, individualized instruction in a variety of settings
- 4. The student accesses and participates in the grade-level TEKS through prerequisite skills.
- 5. The student primarily demonstrates knowledge and skills through performance tasks

What is STAAR-Alternate?

•An alternate assessment to the State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR) for students with significant cognitive disabilities

•An assessment based on the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) curriculum that is linked to grade-level student expectations through *prerequisite skills*

•An observation of student performance on state-developed assessment tasks – not a traditional paper test

Timeline for STAAR-Alt Administration is September - April

Why STAAR Alternative?

Federally mandated by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)

Federal Law says: We must assess **A**// Students **A**// means **A**//

There are <u>No</u> Exceptions!

Changes in STAAR-Alt Student Scores

Increase in Rigor applicable to STAAR-Alt In 2012-2013 It will be necessary to complete at least one complexity level II or III task to reach proficiency
