Consider Adoption of a Resolution Establishing Hazardous Traffic Conditions for the 2026-27 School Year

Background:

Education Code 42.155(d) allows for school districts to receive additional funding for up to 10% of regular transportation allotment for transportation services within 2 miles of the school of attendance who will be subject to hazardous traffic conditions if they walked to school.

As defined in Education Code 42.155 a matrix has been established to rate walk paths within a two-mile radius of CCISD campuses. An evaluation of the district walk zones was conducted during the spring of 2024 by Region IV to evaluate the walk zones to ensure that CCISD students were offered appropriate transportation options for their area. The review provided recommendations defining options the district can consider to ensure the safety of our students.
