DESCRIPTION:

The Early Childhood Family Education, Early Childhood Special Education and KidKare programs are partnering to address the professional development of staff, through a focused innovation strengthening the social/emotional development of preschool children. The Minnesota Department of Education/Centers of Excellence (MDE/COE) innovation is titled: Pyramid Model. The Pyramid Model is a conceptual framework of evidence-based practices for promoting young children's healthy social and emotional development. Based on over a decade of evaluation data, the Pyramid Model has shown to be a sound framework for early care and education systems.

The Pyramid Model was developed by two national, federally-funded research and training centers: The Center for the Social and Emotional Foundations for Early Learning (CSEFEL) and Technical Assistance Center on Social Emotional Intervention for Youth Children (TACSEI). These centers' faculty represent nationally recognized researchers and program developers in the areas of social skills and challenging behavior. Minnesota Department of Education/Centers of Excellence awarded BHM Schools the Pyramid Model Innovation grant on March 7, 2018.

Timeline of Pyramid Model implementation at BHM Schools

- The first meeting of the Implementation Leadership Team is scheduled for June 4, 2019
- Implementation Leadership Team members are from KidKare, ECSE 3-5 years and ECFE
- External Coach: Jodi Altringer (MDE/COE)
- Staff development and training cycle: webinars/online professional development/internal coaching/work across and within teaching teams, over the 5-year implementation period and beyond
- Yr 1: MDE/COE through a JPA provide 100% funding for the innovation (anticipated amount \$12,000)

- Yrs 2-5: Each year MDE/COE through a JPA provide 20% less funding, each year, to support the innovation
- Yr 6: District provides 100% of funding to sustain the innovation
