Thirty-Eight Required High School Courses

Schools must offer

- 38 unique courses, even if a course falls into two categories;
- One math and one literacy transitional course (T);
- At least one Advanced Placement (AP) course in each of the core areas of English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies; and
- Arkansas History if not taught in the 7th or 8th grade.

Schools may submit a request for other courses to meet the 38 through the ADE Course Approval System (CAS).
