WHEREAS, Texas Education Code 25.001(b)(9) requires the District to admit a nonresident student into the District if the grandparent resides in the District and provides a substantial amount of after school care for the student as determined by the Board. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that for the purposes of admitting a student under this provision, the Board of _____Wylie ISD______ School District defines a substantial amount of after school care as at least _3_ hours per school day for _4 days during the regular school week; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the Superintendent to waive the Board-adopted substantial care requirement on the basis of a student's extenuating circumstances and has established the following substantial care criteria for the Superintendent to apply. For a student who does not meet the Board-adopted substantial care definition above, the Superintendent will consider the following criteria, including but not limited to: The number of hours in a typical school day the grandparent provides after school care; 2. The number of days in a typical school week the grandparent provides after school care; 3. The scheduling and commuting needs of the student's parent: 4.
