Subject: Technology Purchases to Support Remote/Distance Learning and Equipment Refresh

Description: The CARES Act supports purchasing of technology to support remote/distance learning for staff and students as well as other needs. Most districts across Montana are taking the opportunity to refresh the technology for their staff and students. It will also address concerns whether we will see the return of equipment to support the 2020-21 school year as high school under classmen have been allowed to keep their assigned devices over the summer and the introduction of the 6th grade class to the middle school building where they have implemented 1:1 iPads for the past 5 years as well as replacing obsolete iPads that are 8-9 years old and are weary on their battery life and no longer support installation of modern day applications for classroom use.
