**Description:** This report includes information about the new Minnesota Science Standards approved by the Department of Education and the Elementary Science Team's process used to align curriculum and instruction to these new standards. This report has been created in collaboration with the Elementary Science Curriculum Design Team and was presented to the Teaching and Learning Board Committee on January 17th, 2023.
