

**Possibly** begin installing Weapons Detection Camera Systems from January to May of 2024. The goal is to be fully operational in August of 2024. Next Step: publish a Request for Proposals (RFP) and bring back to the board for approval.

2025-26

Possibly purchase metal detector systems for the high school arenas and the stadiums. Next Steps: - Staffing cost estimate. The board will be provided a proposal for consideration in May of 2026 to equip both high schools with weapons detection systems and the necessary staffing to operate them for the 2026-27 school year.

2026-27

<u>Possible</u> implementation of weapons detection systems with dedicated staffing at each high school.

2026-27

Study and assess the weapons detection systems at each high school. Research proposed cost for staffing and equipment and identify the feasibility of recommending and expansion to the middle schools in 2027-28. A board presentation for consideration will be given in May of 2027.

2027-28


<u>Possible</u> implementation of weapons detection systems with dedicated staffing at each middle school.
