DESCRIPTION:

Minnesota Statute 121A.335 requires public school buildings serving prekindergarten and K-12 to have a plan to test for lead in potable water sources every 5 years and adopt the plan by School board approval by July 1, 2018. Districts may adopt the model plan as developed by MDE in consult with the MN Department of Health, or adopt an alternative plan.

The enclosed plan would be considered an alternative plan, but it does meet all the required benchmarks of the model plan. It was created with the assistance of our Health and Safety consultant to reflect the testing program that we have had in place for our district since the fall of 2013.
