#### Want to Help a Local Student This Holiday Season?

Did you know that approximately 7% of the total student population of Three Rivers School District are either homeless or living in substandard or overcrowded housing? Every day, the designated family advocates at each school help these students by identifying their needs, and striving to meet them. But while the school district can help homeless students with school supplies, free school meals, and other services, we cannot always provide every student with items to help them get through the holidays.

It is through generous donations from community members, local businesses, other students and their families, and staff that many of our homeless or low income students receive holiday gifts, holiday food baskets, and warm winter clothing.

If you are interested in helping someone this holiday season, consider helping a student at your favorite Three Rivers school. The school staff will ensure that your donations stay local, and help a student and their family in need.

Some schools are conducting holiday food drives, while others work on a holiday basket program.
