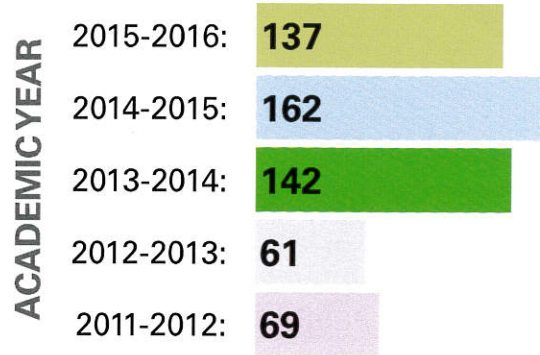

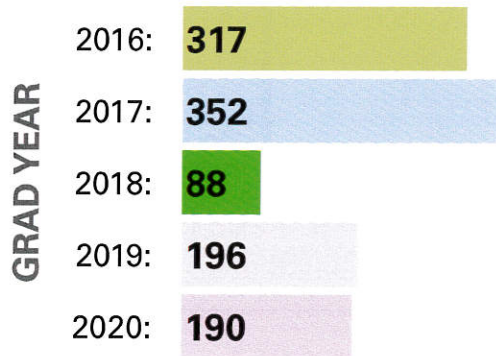
Overall Student Participation by Academic Year

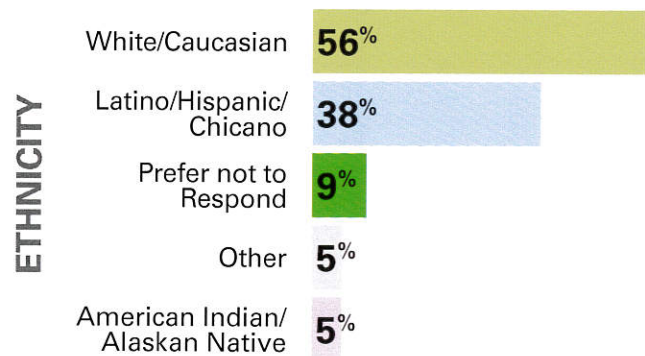
Demographics of Current Student Participation District Wide

Participation by Grad Year



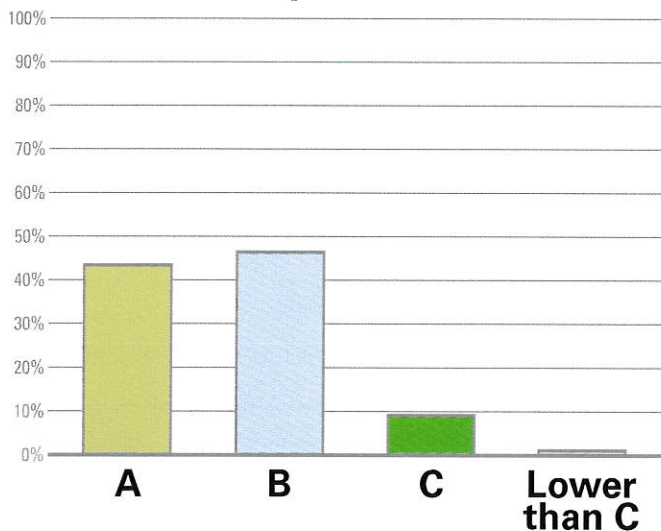

Ethnicity/Race

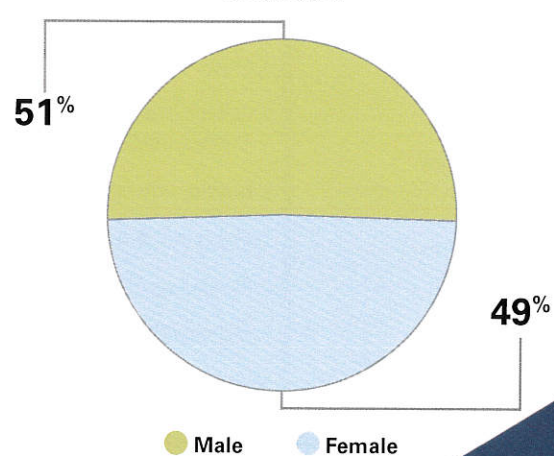

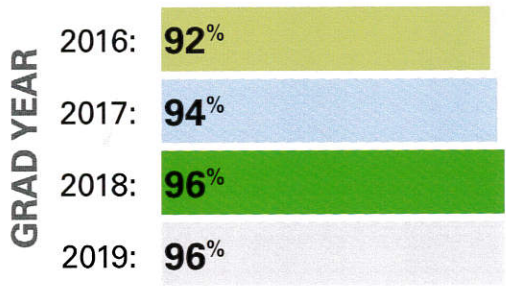

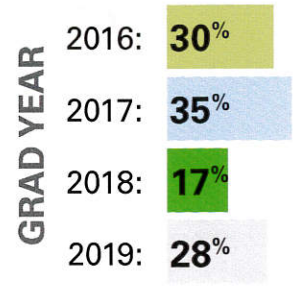

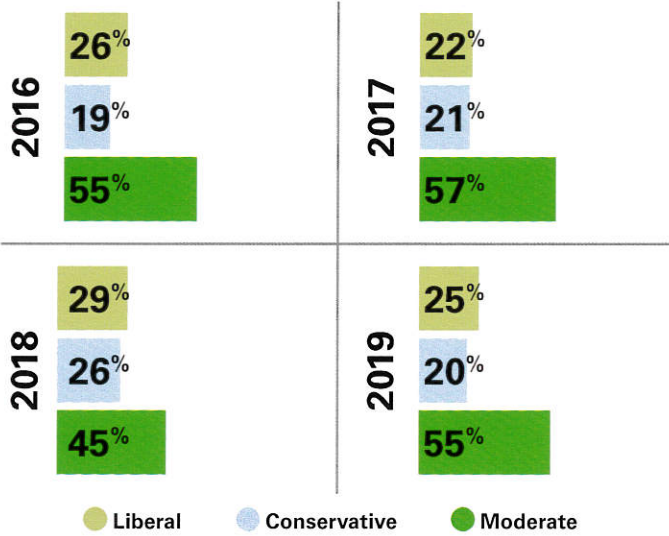

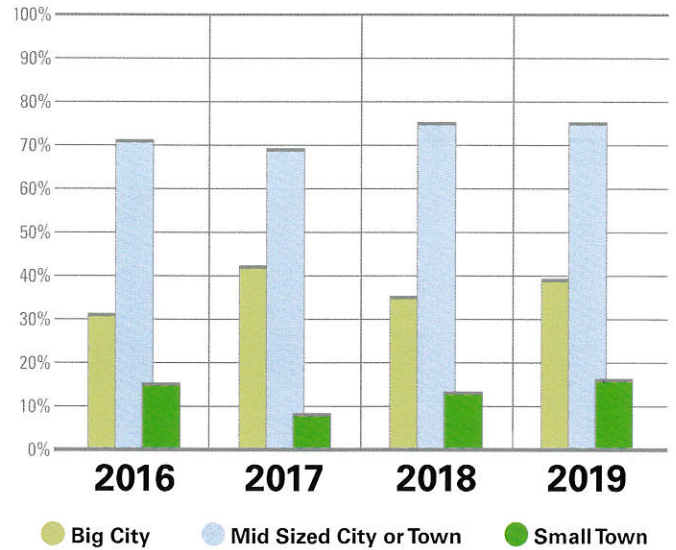

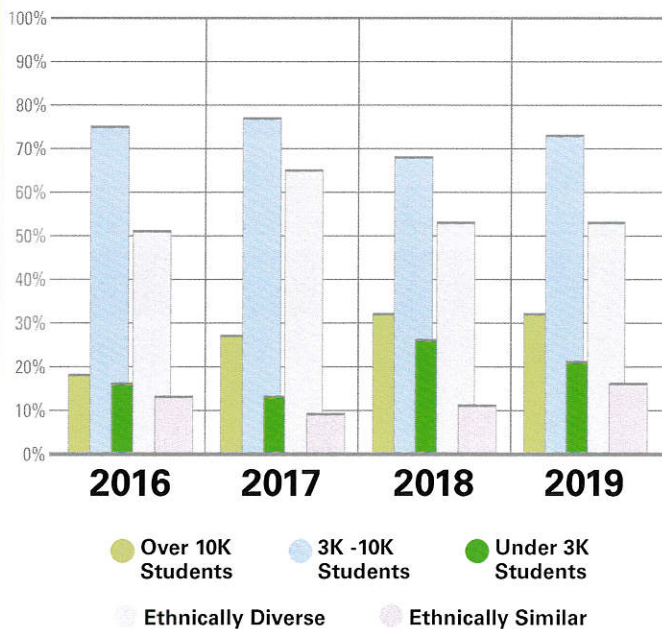
Social Rules on Campus



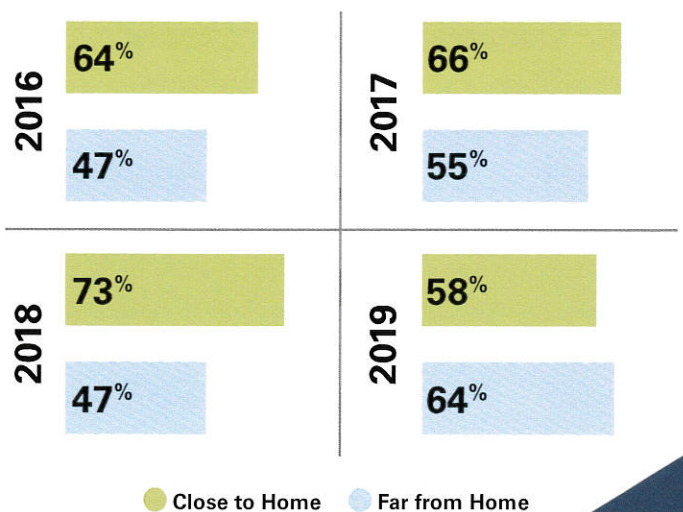
Surrounding Community Type

Ideal Distance from Home

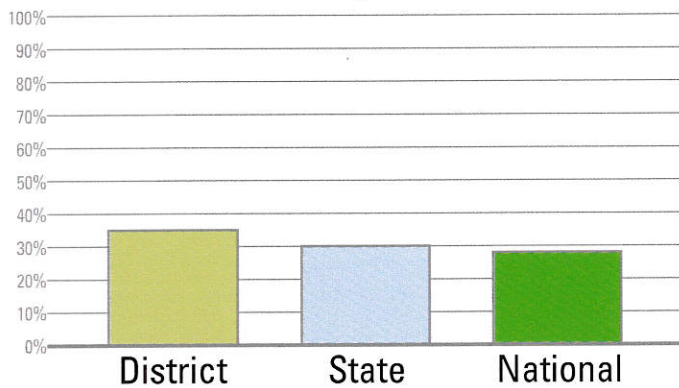




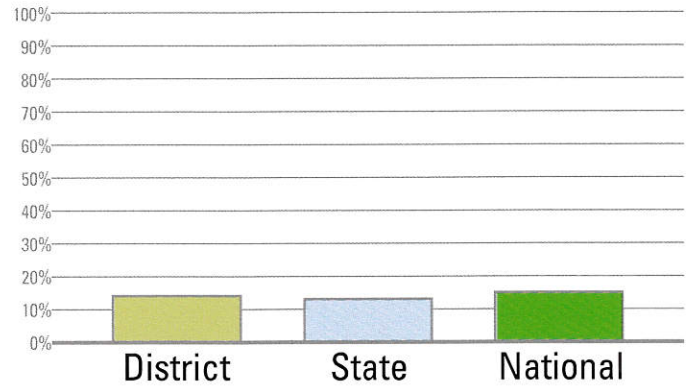
