

Temple ISD District Improvement Plan 2026-2027

Goals & Performance Objectives

Goal 1:	TISD will provide rigorous standards of academic achievement to prepare 21st century learners for academic, career, and college readiness opportunities.
Performance Objective 1	Temple ISD campuses will meet or exceed state standards for the Texas Accountability System.
Performance Objective 2	Temple ISD will increase student participation in Fine Arts, and Athletics by 10%.
Performance Objective 3	Temple ISD will increase the graduation rate to 97% or above and reduce the dropout rate to 1.5% or less.
Goal 2:	Temple ISD will increase family and community partnerships that support a safe and healthy environment for students, staff, families, and the community.
Performance Objective 1	Temple ISD will ensure all campuses meet and or exceed the safety requirements set by the Texas Education Agency.
Performance Objective 2	Temple ISD will develop and maintain academically driven and functionally appropriate facilities where student safety and health are paramount.
Performance Objective 3	Temple ISD will provide support at each campus focused on improving student behavior and bullying prevention, resulting in a 10% decrease of ISS, OSS, and DAEP placements.
Goal 3:	Temple ISD will develop and facilitate a professional culture that support the attendance and participation of students, parents, and staff in school-related activities.
Performance Objective 1	Temple ISD will increase student attendance at each campus to reach a district student attendance rate of 95%.
Performance Objective 2	Temple ISD will recruit, develop, and retain highly qualified teachers and staff in order to reduce the teacher attrition rate from 21.4% to 19.1%.
Goal 4:	The percent of 3rd grade students that score “MEETS grade level” or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 43% to 53% by June 2030. (*43% to 45% by June 2027.)
Performance Objective 1	The percent of PreK students that score "on track" in phonemic awareness on Circle will increase from 76% in 2025 to 80% by June 2027.
Performance Objective 2	The percent of Kindergarten students that score at or above grade level on Map Reading diagnostic will increase from 36% in 2025 to 38% by June 2027.
Performance Objective 3	The percent of 1st grade students that score at or above grade level on Map Reading diagnostic will increase from 49% in 2025 to 51% by June 2027.
Performance Objective 4	The percent of 2nd grade students that score at or above grade level on Map Reading diagnostic will increase from 48% in 2025 to 50% by June 2027.

Goal 5:	The percent of 3rd grade students that score “MEETS grade level” or above on STAAR Math will increase from 42% to 55% by June 2030. (*42% to 44% by June 2027.)
Performance Objective 1	The percent of PreK students that score "on track" in math on Circle will increase from 80% in 2025 to 84% by June 2027.
Performance Objective 2	The percent of Kindergarten students that score at or above grade level on MAP Math diagnostic will increase from 46% in 2025 to 48% by June 2027.
Performance Objective 3	The percent of 1st grade students that score at or above grade level on MAP Math diagnostic will increase from 58% in 2025 to 60% by June 2027.
Performance Objective 4	The percent of 2nd grade students that score at or above grade level on MAP Math diagnostic will increase from 51% in 2025 to 53% by 2027.
Goal 6:	The percentage of students that meet the criteria for CCMR will be maintained at or exceed 90% each year.
Performance Objective 1	The percent of high school graduates meeting the TSI requirement and/or early college credit criteria will increase to 35% by June 2027.
Performance Objective 2	The percent of high school graduates earning an industry certification will increase to 35% by June 2027.
