Re: Senate Enrolled Act 442

Senate Enrolled Act (SEA) 442 specifies requirements for schools providing instruction regarding human sexuality. Human sexuality instruction, for this matter, is defined as: curriculum or lessons that cover topics related to human reproduction, sexual development, relationships, sexual health, responsible decision-making, abstinence, contraception, sexually transmitted infections (STIs), and consent.

The building principal has reviewed the program and materials that will be used in school and is knowledgeable about the content and nature of the instruction. These courses and content have been utilized in our schools in the past with the same requirement for parent consent regarding instruction. In an effort to maintain compliance with recent legislative requirements, the following courses and content are recommended for approval:

- Child Development
- AP Biology (dual credit)
- Genetics
- Health and Wellness
- Introduction to Health Care (dual credit)
- Medical Terminology (dual credit)
