#3281 1 Gifts, Grants and Bequests to the District 2 3 (formerly Grants, Gifts and Donations) 4 5 6 Gifts of personal property to the district, including monetary donations, that meet criteria 7 set forth in the administrative regulations established in accordance with this policy are 8 welcomed and encouraged. 9 10 The Superintendent of Schools shall develop administrative regulations governing the 11 acceptance of gifts and the procedure for examining and evaluating offers of gifts to the 12 district. 13 14 The school principal may approve gifts to a school that are valued at \$500 or under and 15 meet criteria established by the administrative regulations established in accordance with 16 this policy. The Superintendent of Schools must accept gifts that are valued over \$1,000 17 and meet criteria established by the administrative regulations established in accordance 18 with this policy. 19 20 The Superintendent, in consultation with the principals and considering the wishes of the 21 donor, may determine the school(s), program(s) or facility(ies) to which the gift shall go 22 if it is valued at more than \$1,000. The Superintendent shall inform the Board of 23 Education of any gift valued at more than \$1,000 that has been accepted by the district. 24 25 If the Superintendent determines that a gift fails to meet the criteria established in the 26 administrative regulations, the Superintendent shall inform the Board of Education. Any 27 gift rejected by the Board of Education shall be returned to the donor or the donor's estate, 28 with a statement indicating the reason for rejection of such gift. 29 30 Legal Reference: 31 Conn.
