School Improvement

- The high school Building Leadership and Instructional Leadership Teams met before spring break to discuss future planning for School Improvement Goals and Professional Development for staff. Here are the bullet points that will be focused on:
 - o Improving School Culture and Climate this team will focus on the following areas each month:

 - We received the Jostens Pulse Survey Back and will use that information to plan improvements on what and how we recognize students for.
