In pursuit of excellence, the district will foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students.

Purpose of Report

This report shows the attendance percentages for each grade level for the 4th Cycle (January 6, 2015 – February 13, 2015).

Objectives

- District-wide totals are based on the number of students in each grade level.
- Attendance figures are taken from the PEIMS report.
- Attendance figures are based on 28 days (January 6 – February 13).

Operational Impact

The attendance figures from PEIMS are used to determine the district ADA.

Results

- The total attendance average for the Denton ISD for the 4th cycle is 95.6%.
- The lowest total attendance averages are for 12th graders at 92.45% followed by PK at 92.94%.
- The highest attendance averages are in the 5th grade at 96.61% followed by 3rd graders at 96.49%.
- Comparison: 2014's 4th grading cycle was 95.06%
 2013's 4th grading cycle was 95.05%.
