**AGENDA ITEM:** Consider Approval of Missed School Day Waiver

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

If an LEA has closed school due to COVID-19, the agency will provide missed school
day waivers for the closed days with the requirement that the LEA provide educational
supports for the off-campus education of all students. The waivers will be granted as
long as the district commits to supporting students instructionally while absent from the
school grounds. An attestation will be required to be submitted with the waiver by June
18, 2020.

- This waiver is required even if a school district is fulfilling the original calendar days adding up to 75,600 minutes through a distance learning model.
- The waiver begins on the first regularly scheduled instructional date and ends on the last consecutive regularly scheduled instructional date that campuses were closed due to COVID-19. The following date ranges are required to be entered in the Missed School Day Waiver for Aledo ISD.
  - March 23-April 9, 2020
  - o April 14-May 21, 2020
  - May 26-28, 2020
- The school district is responsible for providing all necessary educational resources to a student's parent/guardian and must also provide guidance on how the instruction is to be delivered to the student. TEA auditors may perform random audits to ensure that school districts provided the necessary educational resources.
