<b>Rationale</b>	<p>Due to the rapid growth in the area of 288 and Highway 6 and the lack of available future school sites, it is recommend to make boundary adjustments to zone currently undeveloped land into school zone that can more adequately accommodate growth if development occurs.</p> <p>There is a very limited impact on current student populations. Less than 50 families, impacted families would be allowed to remain at currently zoned campuses for the duration of their student’s tenure on that campus.</p>
