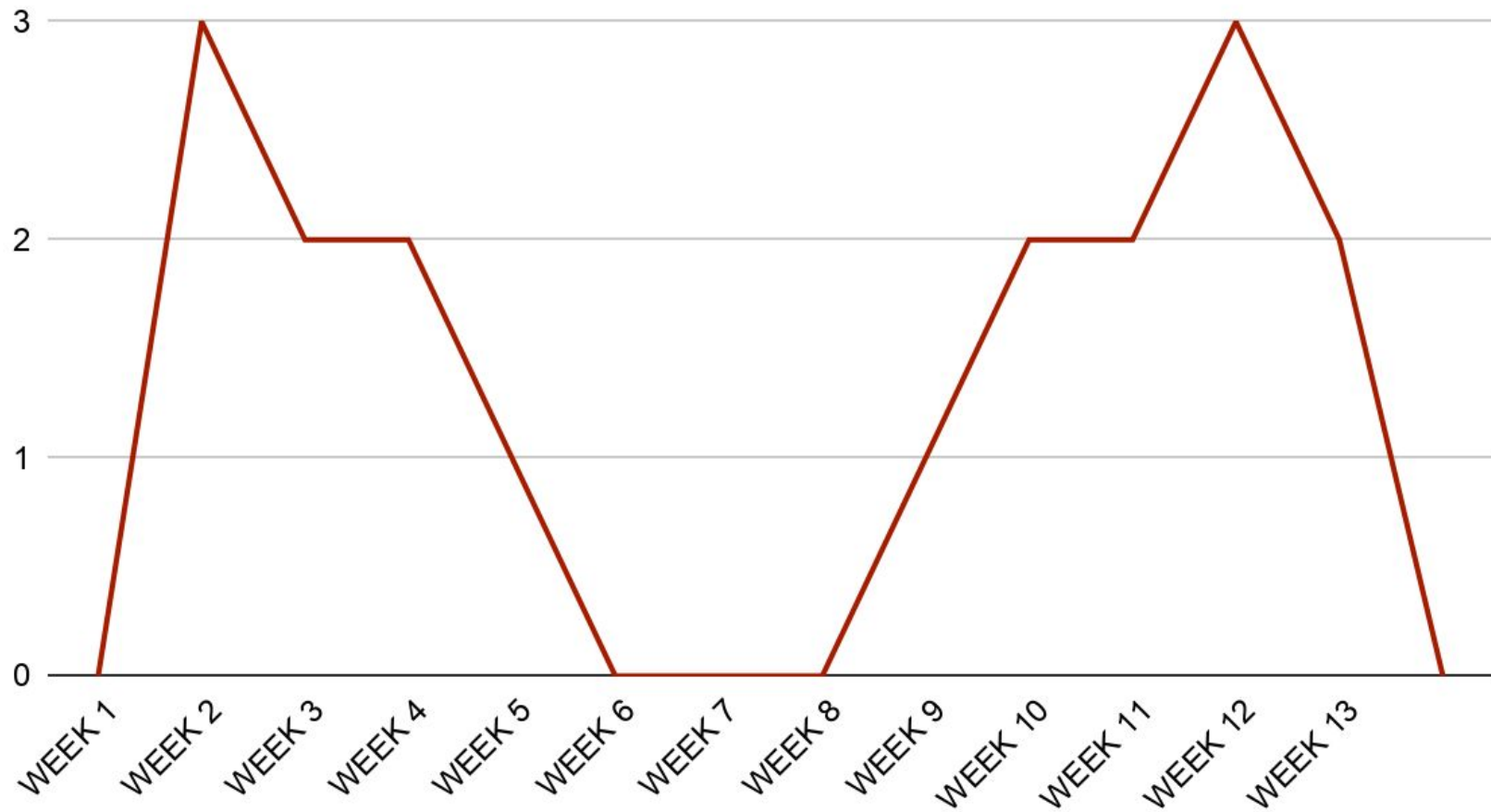


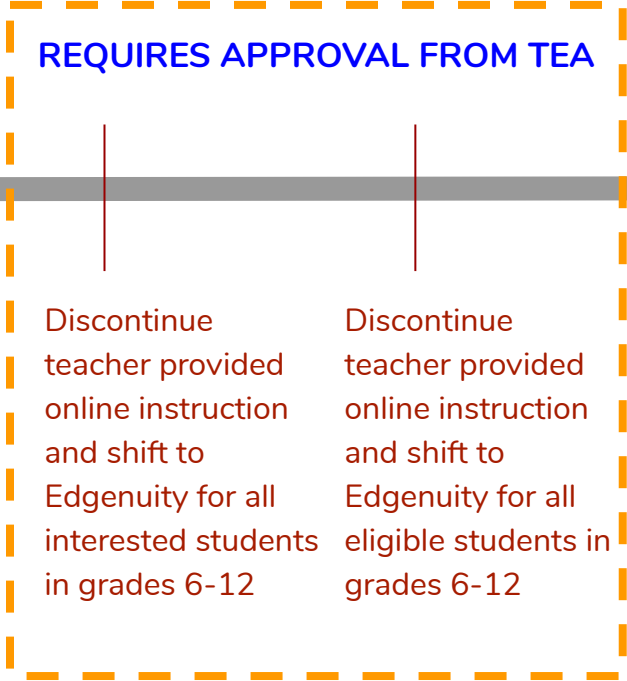
COVID-19 Cases Reported in BISD



ONLINE LEARNING OPTIONS

The Texas Education Agency has authorized local school districts to develop eligibility criterion for student enrollment in a fully online learning platform. The administrative recommendation for Online Learning Eligibility Criterion includes:

- Students must have less than 3 full-day, unexcused absences;
- Students must be passing all classes on each Nine Week Report Card;
- Students participating in onsite extracurricular activities must be enrolled in onsite learning.



Continue “As Is”

Continue Teacher Provided Online Instruction PK-12 Only for Eligible Students

End PK-5 Online Instruction; Continue Teacher Provided Online Instruction for Eligible Students in Grades 6-12

Discontinue teacher provided online instruction and shift to Edgenuity for all interested students in grades 6-12

Discontinue teacher provided online instruction and shift to Edgenuity for all eligible students in grades 6-12

Discontinue fully online learning completely.

Continue "As Is"

Continue Teacher Provided Online Instruction PK-12 Only for Eligible Students

End PK-5 Online Instruction; Continue Teacher Provided Online Instruction for Eligible Students in Grades 6-12

Discontinue teacher provided online instruction and shift to Edgenuity for all interested students in grades 6-12

Discontinue teacher provided online instruction and shift to Edgenuity for all eligible students in grades 6-12

Discontinue fully online learning completely.

Concerned that continued work load will dramatically hurt staff morale. Difficult to align online instruction with onsite-pending access/availability of resources/materials (especially for science);

Hurts online PreAP/AP students' ability to maintain GPA; Requires course changes; Does not align with onsite instruction; diminished need to maintain comprehensive online presence for temporary online students as needed and/or second wave and future preparedness for fully online learning; negates EOC prep.

Limits options amidst spikes.
