- The Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas (FIRST) provides an annual financial accountability rating for all school districts. The 2024-2025 rating (based on 2023-2024 fiscal year data) has been released by TEA and a public meeting providing a presentation of the rating and other disclosed data is required.
