1. Serviced Bus #35 (oil change and grease)
2. Serviced Bus #24 (oil change and grease)
3. Bus #32 Replaced booster pump
4. Bus #27 Repaired (patched) front tire, repaired hydraulic door cylinder, inspection sticker
5. Bus #36 Replaced all 4 brake lights and rear marker lights with LED lights. Old lights were not very visible
6. Bus #30 Repaired outer door light
7. Suburban #7 Replaced all 4 tires
8. '85 S10 truck (maintenance) Replaced alternator
9. '98 Chevy truck (shop) Replaced brake light switch, inspection sticker

Every route bus gets a PM (preventive maintenance) check every week.

Every activity bus and vehicle gets a P.M. check every time they go out.

Every activity vehicle gets washed every time they go out.

Grounds and Fields

Baseball and softball fields – Prepping for new parking lot guard rails. Will order pipe and start installing in January. Waiting on material (Red Clay Mix) for fields to finish them up.
