We are closing in on the end of the Girls Basketball, Boys Basketball and Wrestling seasons.

Girls Basketball-

The Varsity Girls Basketball team is currently 15-5 and 6-2 in conference and will enter the Varsity tournament ranked #1. The JV will play in the Championship game tonight the 4th of February vs Fruitland. Frosh/Soph won their play-in game vs Fruitland but lost to Weiser in the Semi Finals.

Boys basketball-

The boys basketball program is still playing very well and sits at 16-2 (6-0) with two games remaining. It is looking like they will be entering the District tournament as the #1 seed as well. The JV only has 3 losses on the season and is 5-1 in conference while the Frosh/Soph remains unbeaten.

Wrestling-
