I. DESCRIPTION OF ITEM TO INCLUDE YOUR SPECIFIC REQUEST:

Approve to purchase *Achieve3000*, which provides the exclusive nonfiction literacy support on a daily basis (with the progress monitoring, TEKS support, etc) to meet every student at his/her level and move him/her to college and career readiness by using the following differentiators: The Associated Press, Level Set Assessment, Daily Leveled Nonfiction Articles. This program works for ALL students including sub populations such as English Language Learners, Special Education, 504, etc. *Achieve3000* exposes students not only to articles at their literacy level, but also to their grade level text. The program utilizes a diagnostic component, an intervention component, and a bilingual component to help students increase their literacy levels and improve their STAAR/EOC scores. *Achieve3000* follows both the TEKS and the College and Career Readiness Standards.

II. BACKGROUND INFORMATION (DOCUMENTATION):

By partnering with the Associated Press, *Achieve3000* provides daily nonfiction articles differentiated at 12 reading levels in English and 7 reading levels in Spanish. Articles are science and social studies based as well as English Language Arts and Reading. These articles serve to improve STAAR scores. Each article provides writing support and practice for the STAAR/EOC Writing test as well as a math word problem to assist the Algebra I STAAR/EOC. *Achieve 3000* can be utilized by all students and provides all students the same grade level content, but at their individual reading levels. *Achieve3000* scientifically measures the students' ability to read and comprehend nonfiction text.


