

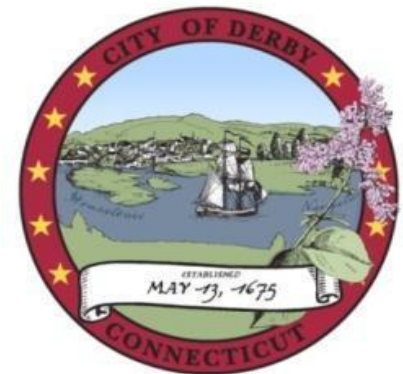

- Laptop distribution will continue through the month and repair issues are handled as they arise.

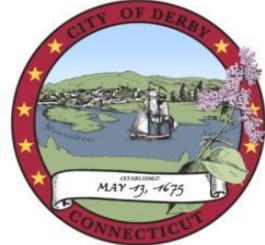
Start of the School Year
