Given this belief, Administration will be posting all Charter School Impact Statement documents within the consent agenda going forward. It is important to provide the community with knowledge of these requests, but it is my belief there is no point in taking up the Board's time with consideration of these items in the "Action Items" portion of the agenda when there is no known identifiable benefit to AISD by approving them.

There are two of these statements found at the Consent Agenda. Both are recommended for disapproval by Trustees.


### C. Student Art Work in Foyer

#### D. Enrollment Update

Staff has followed a trend this year in which the enrollment of our District has slowly decreased from the peak enrollment experienced in the fall. A cursory review of the loss in enrollment is found mainly at the Daniel campus and AHS. Templeton Demographics has been requested to speak to this decline at the next scheduled demographic update in May/June.

The peak enrollment this year was on September 9<sup>th</sup> at 5251 students with a current enrollment of 5172 (as of 3-10-16). The anticipated enrollment was 5180.



### E. Storm Damage Report

At this writing, an accounting is being made of the damages caused by the weather event of March 8<sup>th</sup>. There is known damage to an awning at Aledo HS and to two maintenance facilities along with materials stored at these facilities which was rendered unusable by rain.

It is very roughly estimated the losses will be in the vicinity of \$50,000.
